Dr. Paquet of Philadelphia, arrived here yesterday and left this morning for the Tobique woods.


Mr. J. A. Yoder of Mansfield, Ohio, left this morning for Koswick, where he will hunt with Mr. Rainsford Allen as guide.

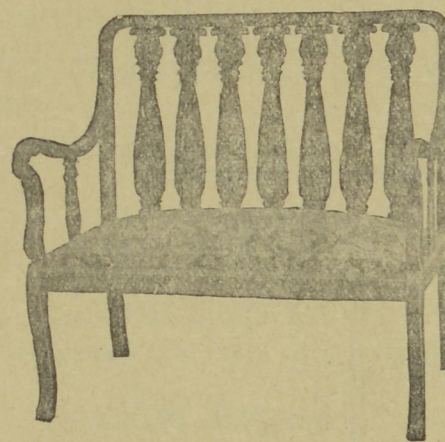
