Blindness Cured After Nineteen Years in the Dark

A remarkable case of faith-healing attracted the attention of medical men in Burnley, Lancashire. He states that shortly after commencing to bathe in the well he felt the sight of his right eye returning. Gradually the sight gained in strength and before he left Holywell he was able to play a game of billiards on a full-sized table.






