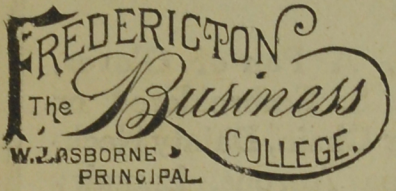

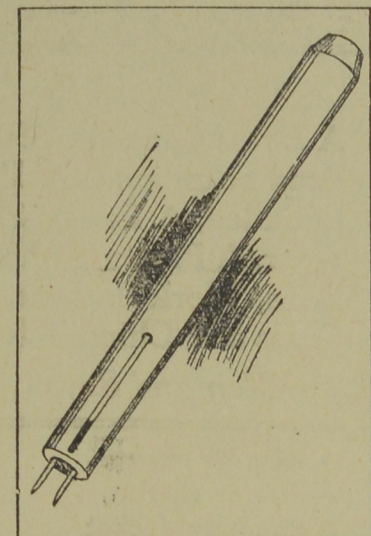

DRIVES STAPLES STRAIGHT

Tool of New Design for Wire Fence Erectors and Other Workmen

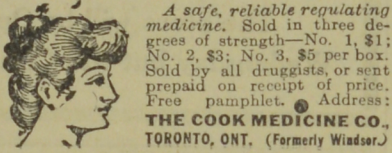
In the erection of wire fence it is generally necessary to drive a large number of staples and for the security of the fence it is desirable that the staples should be driven straight and accurately. Owing to the irregularities of the wooden posts and the strain of

the fence wire, which is under a heavy tension when being erected, it is not always an easy matter to put the staples just where they are wanted to be of the most service.

The tool shown in the accompanying cut is designed to accomplish this. With its aid a great many more staples may be driven in a given time and they are driven in a much superior manner. Besides being a convenience to fence erectors there are other mechanics who will find use for this tool such as electricians, box makers, coopers and the like.

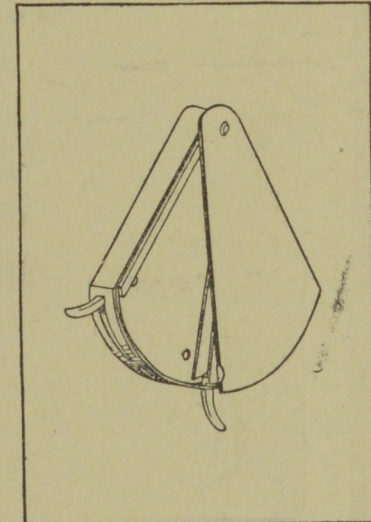

NOVEL LEMON SQUEEZER

Jaws Press in Upon Bisected Fruit and Drain it Dry

An ingenious little lemon or orange squeezer that can be carried in the pocket has been invented. It is a compact device but will do its work just as thoroughly as one of general use. A flat wedge-shaped metal box has an outlet at the wide end. A pair of jaws are enclosed in the box with their inner ends pivoted on the same

pin that holds a swinging lid to the implement. The outer ends of the jaws have finger clips and a spring keeps them normally apart and resting against the sides of the housing. A lemon is cut in half and placed between the jaws, which are then pressed together and the lemon squeezed dry, the juice running into the tumbler or whatever receptacle is waiting for it, through the outlet already mentioned. When the squeezer is not in use the lid can be pushed over it.

**DECLINE SUBSTITUTES****ORIGIN OF GOLD NUGGETS**

Experiments Show That Their Structure Resembles Meteorites

An attempt was made by an investigator in Australia to discover how gold nuggets originate. The first thing done was to cut, slice and polish nuggets with the sole purpose of finding out just what was the nature of their structure.

Close observation revealed the fact that there is some curious points of resemblance between gold nuggets and meteorites. Both when polished and etched with chlorine water, exhibit a crystalline structure. In the case of meteorites the lines thus exhibited on the etched surface are called Widmanstätten figures, and their presence is said to be one of the most invariable characteristics of those metallic bodies that fall from the sky to the earth.

But it is not meant to be implied that gold nuggets have fallen from the sky because they exhibit a crystalline structure recalling that of meteorites. The resemblance is apparently only superficial, and the crystals of the nuggets differ in form from those of the meteorites.

Another curious fact is that when a nugget is heated in a Bunsen flame, explosions take place on its surface. Blistering is formed which continues to swell until they burst with a sharp report and bits of gold are violently scattered about.

It is evident that the nuggets contain either gases or some liquids or solids which are easily converted into the gaseous form, the expansion of which produces the explosions.

Valuable Fisheries
