arrive on Thursday, there are 72,000 dozen, and on the Kaiser Auguste Victoria is a similar quantity, to be landed on Friday or Saturday. Most all of these foreign eggs are small and do not compare with the American production.

Ancient eggs, brought into this city from Chicago as "frozen," have been tabbed by Judge Ray of the Federal District Court. Yesterday he ordered that thirteen cases of them be condemned and destroyed.

For years Armour & Company of Chicago, have been supplying rotten eggs to tanners in the west. They come broken into cans but the first shipment to this city was seized. Thirteen crates were in it.

Armour & Company contended that canned broken eggs were not delivered here for sale as food but exclusively for tanning purposes.

HOOKS OUT FOR OFFENDERS.

Washington, Nov. 25—With eggs nearing the record price of a dollar a dozen in some of the markets in the east, the federal government today has started out with a club to find out who is responsible. The proposition has two possibilities. Either the present anti-trust law, known as the Sherman Act, can be utilized to deal with the offenders of an egg combine or cold storage hold-up, if discovered, or the present congress can, by passing one of the two or three anti-cold storage bills before it, deal directly with the matter.

While the Attorney General of the United States, assuming that the Sherman Act covers the situation, is calling upon his agents all over the United States to sleuth on the allegation that there is an egg combine, the congress of the United States is preparing to discuss the McKellar Cold Storage Bill, which makes it a serious offence to sell or ship any article for human food which has been in cold storage over ninety days.

down—this city and this province must be contented to see the freight of the G.T.P. carried to a port 179 miles more distant from Napodagon than St. John.

What are the mayor and the commissioners of St. John and the St. John Board of Trade and the other business leaders of the community going to do about it?

It must be remembered, also, that with the precedent of the Gutelius-Bostworth agreement before us, the G.T.P. will be in a position to demand Gutelius rates over the Intercolonial from Moncton to Halifax, a concession of the most dangerous character inasmuch as it would mean practically wiping out 179 miles of extra distance for the benefit of Halifax and to the injury of St. John.

What is the use of constructing terminal facilities at Courtenay Bay so long as there is no provision to build the spur from Napodagon to Fredericton and to have the G.T.P. use it and reach St. John by the shortest feasible route?

Once more, what do the mayor and commissioners and the St. John Board and all others who have a stake in St. John, propose to do about it?

Among those who joined in the spirit of Thanksgiving were the members of the Alimony Club in the Ludlow Street jail, who were the guests of the sheriff at a fine banquet at which the sheriff in person presided.

In accordance with a custom which has steadily grown more popular during recent years many thousands of the wealthier people of the city "dined out" today and the restaurants and hotels were crowded all day with diners and merry-makers.

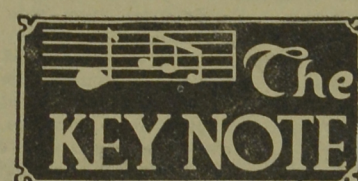
