The record number of ministerial trips to and fro across Canada this summer at the country's expense have been made doubly expensive by the presence of many "invited guests." On the train which brought Hon. Frank Cochrane to Windipeg last week there were no less than seven private cars. Accompanying the minister were many contractors and politicians, including two Conservative M. P.'s, one Conservative Senator, three Conservative members of the Ontario legislature, and the provincial Minister of Lands, Forests and Mines. Hon. J. D. Hazen in his trip across the Dominion had as his guest at the country's expense—a St. John political supporter. Hon. T. W. Crothers took his law partner with him in a Government car to the Pacific coast. Hon. Robert Rogers, who kept a newly-purchased Government car with him all summer, seldom, if ever, traveled without "some of the boys" on board. Hon. Col. Hughes' special train across Canada at a cost of something like \$40,000 needs no comment. Hon. Louis Coderre also had "company" on his recent trip in a government car to the Pacific coast and back. A little later on Hon. W. T. White will requisition a car for a trip through the West. Hon. L. P. Pelletier is now touring the West in a government car. These are but a few of the instances of ministerial jaunting. Altogether it has been a great summer for joy-riding. The activities and the hospitality of the ministers will be adequately represented next year in the Auditors General's report under the heading of "travelling expenses."

A Conservative politician from the North Shore estimates that the Newcastle bridge is going to cost half million dollars. As the bridge is being built by the same concern employed on the Fredericton bridge and upon the same terms, the estimate appears to be well within the mark.

President Campbell, of the Fredericton Agricultural society is being warmly congratulated upon the success of the exhibition. 
