radio equipments. The delegates will suggest the general enforcement of a law requiring all passenger-carrying steamships to be provided with wireless outfits capable of sending messages to a distance of at least one hundred nautical miles. All steamers built to carry twenty-five or more passengers or having a crew of sixty men shall be considered as passenger steamers. They will also suggest that two first-grade operators should be required on ships maintaining constant service and carrying one hundred or more passengers. For cargo boats one first or second grade operator and one cargo operator or watcher is to be recommended. Other recommendations will refer to the raising of the standard of efficiency of the crews on all passenger steamships and the requirement of adequate fire-fighting appliances and the systematic drilling of the crews in the use of the appliances.

## YORK BY-ELECTION IN JANUARY

St. John, Nov. 12.—Provincial Secretary McLeod, O. S. Crockett, M. P., J. K. Pinder, M. P. P., and John A. Young, M. P. P. are here today and held a conference with Hon. J. D. Hazen and Hon. Bob Rogers, Minister of Elections in the Borden Cabinet. They urged that Mr. Crockett's appointment to the bench be made without further delay, and suggested that the by-election to fill the vacancy be called on early in the month of January.

Both Pinder and Young expressed a willingness to contest the seat, but the ministers are inclined to favor Mr. Pinder. Hon. Mr. Rogers seemed to be very favorably impressed with the King of the Neck and promised him every assistance.

Premier Flemming is known to have strong preference for McLeod as the Federal candidate, but the Provincial Secretary declares that he will remain in local politics.

## LIBERALS WIN A GREAT VICTORY

London, Nov. 11.—The Right Hon. Stanley Owen Buckmaster was re-elected today for the Keighley division of Yorkshire, west riding, in the bye-election made necessary by his appointment to the position of solicitor general.

In the three-cornered fight he was opposed by the Union, Viscount Lascelles, son and heir of the Earl of Harewood, and the Labor candidate, Mr. Bland.

The poll was as follows:  
Stanley, O. Buckmaster, Liberal, 4,730.  
Viscount Lascelles, Rho.nist, 3,852.  
Mr. Bland, Labor, 3,646.  
In the previous bye-election in 1911, Mr. Buckmaster received 4,667 and the Unionist and Labor candidates 3,842 and 3,542 respectively.

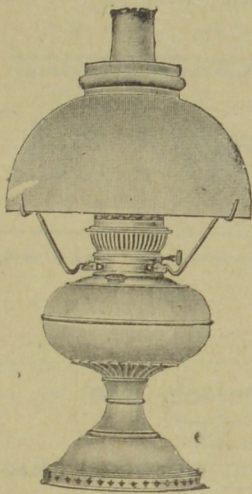

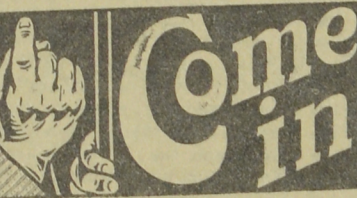
