One Fish Provided a Meal for 1,000 People

Very seldom indeed is the sturgeon

This fish, which according to the estima an cartridges used were loaded wi size and weight may be gathered from the fact that five men were require to land it. means the largest sturgeon which been caught in English waters. as much as 562 pounds and 73 pounds have been captured by trav ers. It is pointed out that one the most remarkable facts about the fish netted in the North Sea is they are similar to the America species, whence it would seem that the specimens caught from time time in our waters must have ma the voyage across the Atlantic, si the fish appears to have died out as a regular inhabitant of British waters. ide.
