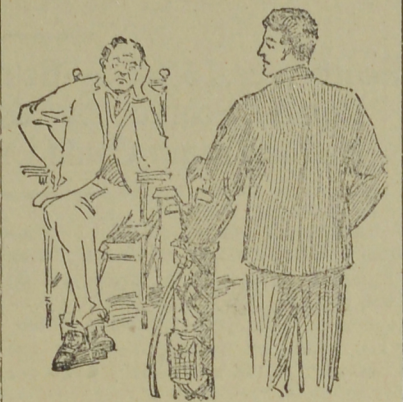

The treasury was the last to feel the pinch, as it will be the last to feel the recovery.

LAVISH EXPENDITURE.

Mr. Foster and Mr. Fielding have been through this sort of time in the past but they made preparations. They saw what was coming and cut down expenditure. Not so Mr. White. Hon. Robert Rogers told him that the government which was the most popular was the government which spent most. So last session closure was applied to parliament and the government passed the greatest budget Canada has seen.

Today Hon. Mr. White has spent all the ready money the country owns and has borrowed heavily. It was thought that the time had been reached when Canada was through paying four per cent. for money, buy Hon. Mr. White, who recently borrowed many millions, has been compelled to pay even more than four per cent. for every dollar. He is most thankful to the Senate for saving the thirty-five millions Mr. Borden wanted to blow on battle-ships.

Still, estimates are being curtailed. The budget is not likely to reach the two hundred million dollar mark this year.

Hon. Mr. White is out for economy at last and is determined to save what he can of his reputation as a financier.

MR. HAWKES EXPLAINS

"Nothing seems clearer than that the country is desirous of making up its mind what to demand from its servants at Ottawa, and that it is time for public opinion to assert itself, if there be such a power in the dominion.

"Dumb elections can only be harmful elections. The people who are always railing against the excesses of party politics are being given a chance to implement their complaints by aiding a non-partisan candidate who at least has the courage to fight for the things he believes in, and who will welcome the support of every kind whenever it comes.

"At the Smiths Falls meeting on Monday night I expect to endorse the campaign of the Montreal Daily Mail for simplicity in electioneering, and to invite the Mail to help in proving that an election can be run as regards ethics and finance on lines that are as decent as we all look for in the ordinary amenities of life."

Premier Riblin's reference to Hon. Mr. Samuel, postmaster general of Great Britain as "that jelly bag of an Englishman" is not likely to make any friends for the Manitoba government among the British-born of that province.

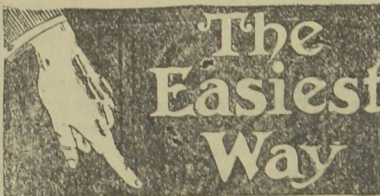
