

At a suitable time of the year the piles are burnt. Another method of reducing the danger from fires is by lopping and scattering; that is to say by trimming the tree tops left by the loggers and thus bringing the brush close to the ground where it



An example of a lumbering slash where the tops have not been lopped. A fire would spread with tremendous rapidity in such a slashing and would be exceedingly difficult to fight. Good forestry practice obviates danger of this nature.
