Garnet and Gold has. Mount A.'s big margin over U.N.B. is made up largely by two runaway scores that Mt. Allison piled up at Sackville, games in that town always proving unlucky to U.N.B. Acadia's scoring ability against Mt. Allison has been more than double and against U.N.B. about three times as great. Against U.N.B., Mount A. had more than four times the scoring ability.

The U.N.B. teams have never been able to win away from home in the Intercollegiate Series. The Red and Black has tied Mount A. at Sackville and drawn with Acadia at Wolfville. Had straight Rugby scoring rules been observed the Red and Black would have had three other drawn games, one at Wolfville, one at Sackville and one against Acadia at Fredericton.

Inability to score has been the great fault of the U.N.B. teams. When the series first started the Red and Black showed a tendency to score but afterward slumped. About five years ago scoring ability on the part of the local college team again showed itself to be followed by another slump, which was followed this year by an exhibition of scoring ability which just failed of winning the cup. Had the Red and Black played Acadia at Fredericton and Mount A. at Sackville this season, the chances are that the cup would now be here.

The result of the whole series shows that the best football college has won the trophy, Acadia showing the best all-around form through the eleven years.

## NEWS FORECAST FOR THE COMING WEEK

Washington, D. C., Nov. 15.—President Woodrow Wilson is to deliver the opening address at the fifth annual meeting of the National Conservation Congress, which will assemble in Washington Tuesday for a three days' session. The meeting this year is to be devoted principally to the consideration of forestry and water power subjects.

Other important gatherings of the week will include the annual meeting of the Atlantic Deeper Waterways Association and the annual convention of the National Wholesale Druggists' Association, both of which are to be held in Jacksonville, Fla.

The National Association of Shell-Fish Commissioners has issued a request for a nation-wide observance of "shell-fish day" next Friday. On that day people in the various shell-fish producing States are expected to make a specialty of place.

## ALBERTA FARMERS FIND NEW MARKET

Prince Albert, Nov. 12.—Recent American legislation removing the duty on cattle entering the United States has had far reaching effects in this district, because of its great mixed farming area. Buyers have been scouring the whole countryside purchasing stock and in consequence the market value has taken a rapid rise. Large shipments have been made and congestion on the railway lines and in the stock yards at Winnipeg is the immediate result. One firm in Prince Albert received an order for 700 head, and the same company, during the last five weeks, has shipped 1,500 head of cattle to various points. They now have in their yards 600 head of excellent stock, 'one animal weighing 2,360 pounds, and another consignment of 400 is expected this week.
