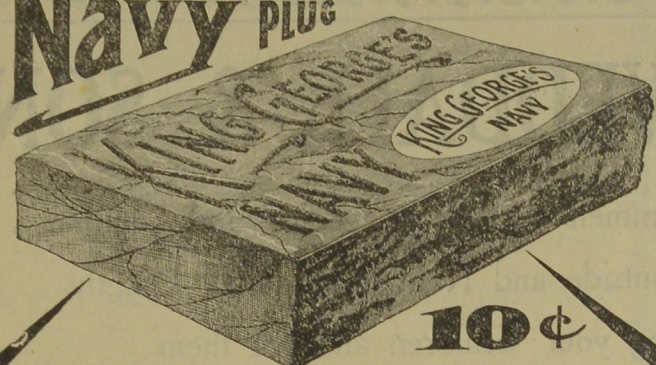

## WHEN YOU LAUGH SPELL IT 'LAF'

New York, March 24—The Simplified Spelling Board has issued its fourth list of words to appear in new fashioned orthography. Approximately, 1,000 words are shortened or changed in spelling.

In considering these new spellings the board said, in announcing the new list, 'do not be too much influenced by the odd appearance of the word. Any change may look odd at first. Consider, rather, whether the change will bring a real gain if the public should accept it.'

Some of the changes are: Dropping the silent h in such words as chaos and chamelon; dropping the final k in words like hammock; changing heart and hearth to hart and harth; dropping the silent e in money and similar words; substituting lai for laugh, and eol for cough; omitting the g in gnat, gnome and similar words; substituting nee for knee and nicap for kn-knac and dropping the k in similar words; changing pranced to pranst and other words ending with need to 'nst.

In the new list touch is spelled tuch; serious is changed to derius; blow is spelled blo; bellow is changed to bello; forced to forst; phantom to fantom; handsome to handsum; boss to bos; glue to glu and wretched to retched. Each of these instances typifies a rule and is followed by a long list of words to which it applies.

## ASKS LARGE SUM FOR MISSIONS

Toronto, March 24—The Home Mission Board of the Presbyterian Church, which has concluded a four days session here considers that no less than \$1,400,000 will be required if the home mission work is to be in a reasonable manner overtaken.

The estimates for the missionary operations now entrusted to the board of the western section are \$809,000 distributed as follows. For Home Missions proper, \$425,000; augmentation \$125,000; French Mission work \$50,000; work of district superintendents \$30,000; work of administration \$15,000; travelling and incidental expenses \$5,000; immigration, \$15,000; Indian missions, \$12,000; Jewish work, \$15,000; literature \$10,000; outfits, \$7,000.

It is felt that when the church is fully seized with the grandeur of the task before it, at this formative period in the history of the country, it will rise to the opportunity and furnish all the money necessary to cope with the situation. Much is expected from the missionary congress preceding the meeting of assembly and the churches are asked to make it a subject of constant prayer that it may be a second Pentecost for the church in Canada.

The board has determined on a policy for mission work in large cities. The establishment of new churches has hitherto been largely left either to the strong city
