Therefore we can answer regarding this false dilemma of dominion ships that they are additional to the requirements of the 60 per cent standard. They are not additional to the world-wide requirements of the British Empire."

sumed the European wars are tightening the money markets. Mr. Sterling and Mr. Spurden were appointed a committee to ascertain if better conditions can be found in other banks.

## DECREASE IN ESTIMATES

The estimated cost of the schools for the next year engaged the attention of the Board for some time, and it was found impossible to face the year with any sum less than \$21,000—the past two years the expenditure over ran the assessment, and with the utmost care will probably do so again. In addition to regular assessment the Board of Health demands a complete change in the sanitary arrangements at York Street School. It is thought the proposed plan will call for an expenditure of \$3000.00 Dr. Crockett, Mr. Spurden, and Mr. Sterling were appointed a delegation to explain situation to City Council.

Some correspondence from Dr. Foster, Principal of High School, disposed of at a previous meeting was again under consideration, when the previous action of the Board was affirmed.

Mrs. Clark reported respecting preparation of blanks for monthly reports of teachers to Trustees.

Salaries of teachers were ordered paid and a number of accounts ordered after which the meeting was adjourned.

Mr. George Foss of Gibson left last night for the Canadian West intending to locate there.

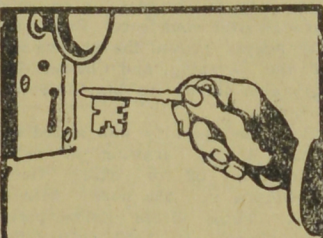
Mr. Colm Campbell is able to be out after a lengthy illness.

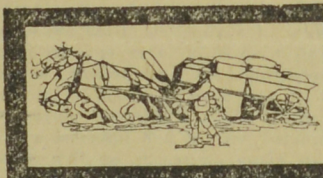

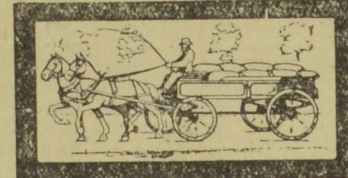

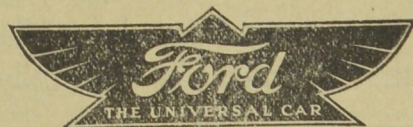
