

RICE PUDDING

1-2 cup rice
2 cups water
2 cups milk
1-2 cup cream
1-8 cup cinnamon
2 eggs
1-2 cup sugar
1-4 teaspoon salt
3 drops vanilla

Cook rice in water ten minutes until rice is tender add milk, cream and cinnamon and cook in a double boiler ten minutes. Mix egg yolks, sugar and salt and stir into this a little of the hot mixture. Stir this into the rest of the rice mixture and cook five minutes, stirring lightly with a fork. Remove from fire, take out cinnamon, add vanilla and pour into serving dish to chill.

CHOCOLATE PUDDING

1 loaf bread
1 cup milk
Butter
Yolks of 4 eggs
3-4 cup sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla
1-2 square sweet chocolate, grated
Whites of 4 eggs

Cut crust off bread and crumb, soak in milk. Beat yolks and sugar together, then add bread, vanilla and chocolate. Fold in whites of eggs beaten stiff. Mix well and put in a steamer that is well buttered and cracker crumbs at bottom of steamer. Steam in hot water for two hours and do not allow water to come higher than the tightly fitting cover.

DATE CAKE

3-4 cup of butter
2 cups of sugar
3 eggs
1 cup of jam or marmalade
3 cups of flour
2 teaspoons of baking powder
1-2 teaspoon of salt
1-2 teaspoon of soda
1 teaspoon of cinnamon
1-4 teaspoon of nutmeg
1-4 teaspoon of allspice
1-2 cup of sour milk or buttermilk
12 dates chopped fine
1-2 cup of chopped pecans

Cream the shortening and three-fourths cup of sugar. Beat the egg yolks with the remaining sugar and mix the two. Add the marmalade. Sift the dry ingredients and add alternately with the sour milk. Add the dates and nut meats, mixing well. Fold in the stiffly beaten egg whites and bake in layers in a moderate oven, and ice with a butter mocha icing.

BUTTERSCOTCH STARS

3-4 cup butter
2-3 cup brown sugar
2 cups flour
1 teaspoon vanilla
Citron
Cream butter, add sugar gradually and cream together. Add sifted flour and vanilla and mix until smooth. Chill. Roll out thin on a slightly floured board, cut with a star cutter. Brush with egg yolk and place a small star, cut out of citron, in the center of each cookie. Bake in a moderate oven, 375 degrees F. 10 minutes


