

Former Iowa Rural School Teacher Tells How She Made \$324 in One Season.

One of the most profitable side lines for the women of the farms is turkey raising. These fowls require considerable care while young, since they are the most delicate of all the feathered tribe in the baby stage. But once they are feathered out they seem to be among the most hardy of all domesticated poultry and, with the farm to range over, they need very little feed or attention, except two or three weeks of fattening before being marketed.

The experience of an Iowa woman who made more than \$300 with turkeys in a single season is worthy of record. This woman is Mrs. Geo. Wallace, of Warren County, who formerly was a rural school teacher. She says she would rather raise turkeys than teach a country school.

"How did I do it?" she replied to an inquiry. "Well, I believe in pure-bred turkeys. I built up my crop of turkeys by importing a Naragansett tom that cost \$25, and several hens worth \$7 to \$8 apiece. With this combination of new, unrelated stock, my hens not only laid well, but the eggs hatched well. At least 50 per cent. of the eggs hatched and the youngsters reached matur-

'My turkeys hatch about June 1. I give them nothing for 48 hours. The first meal is boiled eggs, plus one grain of pepper to the bird. After a week I change them gradually to chick feed and corn. I then turn them into a large hog-tight pasture. If a bird gets sick I usually separate and doctor or kill it. "My turkeys are plucked before they are marketed. By merely bleeding and removing the feathers I get them from 5 to 6 cents more per pound for them.

I sent 1692 pounds of turkeys to the city and got \$324.95 for them.
