

MY NEIGHBOR SAYS

To prevent starch sticking to your iron, put a small lump of butter and a good shake of salt into starch after it is made.

Rugs will wear longer and more evenly, in a room that is in constant use, if turned every six months.

To take a grease spot off wall-paper, apply a paste of cornstarch and water. When dry, brush off and the stain will be gone.

To open oysters easily, place them on the warm kitchen stove for a second, then insert the knife between the thin edges of the shell. They will open without trouble.

A good ventilator to use in bedroom windows is made by fitting a board six or eight inches high and just the width of window below the lower sash.

To loosen a glass stopper in a bottle put one or two drops of sweet oil around the stopper and place it a little distance from the heat. When the bottle is quite warm strike the stopper with a stick with a cloth wrapped around it first on one side and then on the other. This will loosen even the most obstinate stopper.

FONDANT

Two cups sugar
1-2 cup water
2 tablespoons light corn syrup
1 teaspoon vanilla

Put water, sugar and syrup into a saucepan and cook, stirring constantly until sugar is dissolved. Remove spoon and do not stir candy again during cooking. When candy begins to boil cover saucepan and let it boil for 3 minutes. (The steam formed will wash away the little sugar crystals which form on side.) Remove cover and continue cooking to soft ball stage. Remove from fire, put on a cold wet platter on oiled slab. Cool to lukewarm, then take a spatula and beat until it becomes white and creamy. Put away in crock or glass jar and allow to ripen from 2 to 3 days before using. Color if you like.

CEREOLE ROLL

Three cups sugar
1 cup rich milk
1 package dates
1-2 pound pecan meats

Place sugar and milk (evaporated milk may be used) in a saucepan, stir over a low flame until sugar is dissolved; increase heat and boil to 238 degrees F. the soft ball stage. Add sliced dates and cook to 242 deg. F. (2 to 3 minutes additional boiling). Remove from stove; cool; beat until candy begins to thicken. Add broken nutmeats and continue beating until mixture is firm enough to form into a roll about one inch in diameter. Wrap in a wet cloth and let stand until thoroughly cold. Remove cloth and cut in slices. May be rolled in chopped nuts or shredded cocoanut before slicing.

FANCY CARAMELS

2 cups sugar
1 cup brown sugar,
1 cup light corn syrup
1 cup cream
2 cups milk
1-2 cup butter
2 teaspoons vanilla
1 package dates

Put all ingredients except vanilla and dates into a saucepan and cook, stirring constantly over a low flame until candy forms ball in water (246 degrees F.). Remove from fire, add vanilla and dates, turn at once into slightly greased pans. When cold remove from pan; cut into squares with hot knife and wrap, 2 1-2 pounds.

SILVER LINING FUDGE

One cup sugar
1 tablespoon light corn syrup
1-3 cup milk
1-2 cup shredded cocoanut

One cup sugar
1 tablespoon light corn syrup
1-3 cup milk
1-2 teaspoon vanilla
1 square chocolate
1 tablespoon butter
1-4 cup nut meats
1-2 cup dates

PART I.—Place sugar, corn syrup and milk in a deep saucepan. Stir over low heat until sugar is dissolved, then cook to soft ball stage (236 to 238 deg. F.). Remove from stove.

Add butter and vanilla; cool until lukewarm; then beat until creamy; add cocoanut and turn into buttered loaf pan.

PART II.—While Part I is cooking place sugar, corn syrup, milk and chocolate in a saucepan. Proceed as in Part I. Add chopped nuts and dates and pour this chocolate mixture over the cocoanut mixture (part 1 mixture) in the loaf pan. Cut in small squares when cold. About 1 3-4 pounds.

KRIS KRINGLES

Use a pulled fig for the body. Insert a wire through the top and bottom. Cover the wire with pitted dates for arms and legs and raisins for hands and feet. Bend as the fancy dictates. Attach a marshmallow head by means of a toothpick neck. "Blondes" are made by dipping the head into corn syrup and then into toasted cocoanut. "Brunettes" are produced by dipping the head into melted chocolate and then into chocolate "shot."
