**GERMAN THREATS OVER THE BARALONG CASE**

BERLIN, Aug. 15.—The government has transmitted to the Reichstag a white book, in regard to the British patrol boat Baralong, members of the crew of which are alleged to have killed Germans from a submarine over a year ago.

After reciting that negotiations for a settlement of this case have been unsatisfactory, the report from the Overseas News Agency says reprisals will be taken against England, and that in future "Zeppelins will be used against England without any regard to the limits of the laws of nations. Any airship which throws destructive bombs on London or other defended towns, or on towns which contain establishments of a military character, shall cause England to remember the Baralong case."

**ITALIAN TROOPS NEARING TOLMINO**

Paris, Aug. 15.—Italian troops have entered the suburbs of Tolmino, which is under continuous shell fire, according to a despatch to La Liberté from Tourin today. The Austrians, says the despatch, are evacuating the city.


