## NO DISSENTING VOICE AGAINST PEACE PROPOSALS

**Members of the Reichstag Were Silent And Unmoved While Chancellor Delivered His Speech---Allied Governments Will Not Act Hastily---Comment of the American Newspapers---Mr. R. B. Bennett's Views.**

Berlin, via London, Dec. 13.—The speech of Chancellor Von Bethmann-Hollweg before the Reichstag today, in which he declared that Germany was willing to make peace, was not marked by a single expression of dissent while the significant passages were greeted with hearty bravos and cheers. It was noticeable, however, that Count Friedrich Von Westarp, Conservative leader, and others of his following, sat silent and unmoved, even when the galleries and newspaper men joined in the demonstrative applause.

The indefinite adjournment of the Reichstag by its own decision leaves the government a free hand to conduct further negotiations and is regarded as tantamount to a vote of confidence.

### Allies Will Not Act Hastily.

London, Dec. 13.—The indications are that the various governments of the Entente Allies do not intend to act hastily in making joint response to the peace proposals of the Central Powers. It was pointed out in well-informed quarters today that while each one of the Allied governments might indicate its general attitude, consultation among the Allies under the treaty binding them such action probably would require two or three weeks.

New York Herald.

New York, Dec. 13.—The Herald, commenting on the German peace proposal, says:

"Chickens are coming home to roost at Berlin. All the circumstances surrounding the proposal for peace strengthen the conviction that it has one object only—to put a quietus upon the rapidly growing protest throughout Germany against the continuation of a war which the German people can no

longer believe to be a war of defence, however much their pride may have been stirred by the successes in Belgium, Serbia and Roumania, and the gigantic losses in men must have produced deep depression; and the fact that such losses have occurred in fighting on foreign soil, not in defending the hearths and homes of the Fatherland" has undoubtedly militated against popular willingness to incur further sacrifices."

### Boston Comment.

Boston Globe: The German government would not talk peace if it thought it could win world dominion. Whether the terms offered are acceptable or not, the fact remains that they are explicit and might thus be made the basis of serious negotiations. That they should be offered at all by the proudest military despot on the planet is a startling event.

Boston Advertiser: "The proposed terms of 'lasting peace' insure nothing in the future except that the same causes which produced this war would remain, festering and wholly unsettled, to breed some new horror when the worst of this present horror should be forgotten by another generation, if not in the near future."

### Ottawa Citizen.

Ottawa, Dec. 13.—The Ottawa Citizen says in commenting of the German peace proposal:

"That the enemy realizes that so far as victory is concerned the chances in his case are remote, is a source of gratification to all friends of the Allies. It will be interpreted in its proper sense in all the countries opposed to the Triple Alliance. The Allies know what they want and what they think is
