

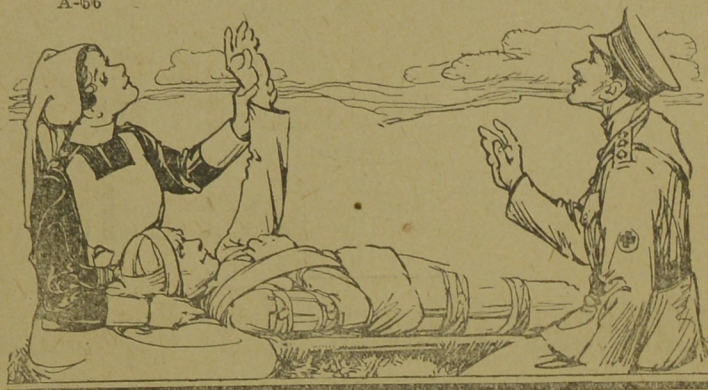

CORRESPONDENTS TO VISIT GRAND FLEET

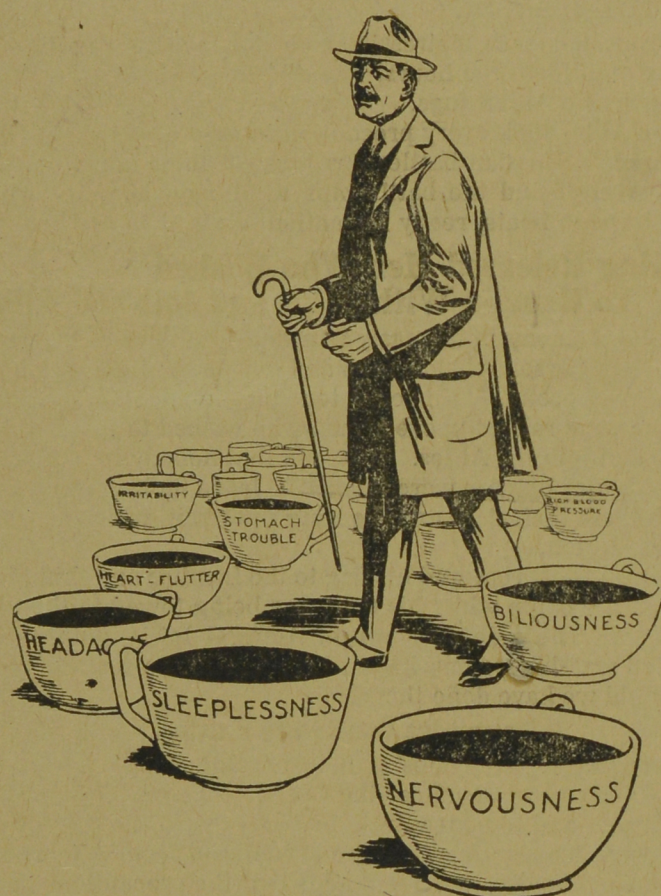
Montreal, Oct. 12.—A Gazette cable from London says:

NASHWAAK PULP & PAPER COMPANY INCORPORATED

Will Take Over Partington Business—
Intentions Not Yet
Announced.

Nothing is announced yet concerning the intentions of the Nashwaak Pulp & Paper Co. and its properties at Marysville, but it is expected that something will be made known shortly. It is expected that a pulp mill will be built either at or near Marysville.

The Royal Gazette of this week contains official announcement of the incorporation of this company. The incorporators are Hugh J. Chisholm, of Portland, Me., capitalist; Llewellyn H. Bickford, of New York City, paper manufacturer, and Maynard S. Bird, of Rockland, Me., broker.

The company is empowered to take over the business of the Partington Pulp and Paper Co., and conduct it in all its branches. The head office is to be at Union Point, St. John county, but annual meetings can be held in the United States.

The capital stock is \$75,000, divided into fifteen thousand shares without par value, which can be sold at \$5 per share.

REAR ADMIRAL KNIGHT'S SUBMITS HIS REPORT

U. S. Navy Department Now Has the Evidence of the Captains of Submarine Victims.

Washington, Oct. 12.—The Navy Department today received a report from Rear Admiral Knight at Newport, giving detailed accounts from the commanders of four of the steamers sunk by a German submarine off the New England coast.

Naval officers refused to comment upon its contents and it will be transmitted to Secretary of State Lansing in connection with the determination of the policy of the United States.

EVIDENTLY NOT DOVE OF PEACE.

Had Number of German Submarine Raider on Its Leg.

Edgewater, N. J., Oct. 12.—The police are holding prisoner a white dove with a band of yellow metal on its leg bearing the inscription U-53, the number of the German submarine which made its memorable raid off Nantucket last Sunday.

The dove fluttered in the window of a business office here yesterday. Its captors did not know from whence it came.

A WEST INDIA HURRICANE

Does Much Damage in Danish Islands and Relief is Required.

Washington, Oct. 12.—The United States consul at St. Thomas reported today that the hurricane which swept the Danish West Indies on Monday and Tuesday caused damage estimated at \$2,000,000 and left two-thirds of the native islanders in dire need of food and clothing and shelter. His despatch said:

"Disaster general. Estimated loss \$25,000,000. Two-thirds of the population need food and clothing, one-third shelter. Relief required, \$50,000, including building material, food, clothing and money."

ANOTHER NORWEGIAN VICTIM.

London, Oct. 12.—A Renter despatch from Christiania announces the sinking of the Norwegian steamer Birk, of 715 tons. The crew was saved.

IT'S LY SUFFERING FROM COAL SHORTAGE

Rome, via Paris, Oct. 12.—The resumption of Austro-German submarine attacks are causing grave concern in Italy, where the prices of coal, wheat, lumber, scrap iron and other imports have trebled within a year, owing to the prohibitive freight rates.

The railroads have a stock of 200,000 tons of coal, however, and are not likely to be interrupted during the winter. Coal now costs \$50 a ton.

Ottawa, Oct. 12.—Word has been received here that the despatch reporting the death of Edward W. Tobin, Liberal M. P. for Richmond and Wolfe, is not correct.

HON. COLONELS MUST "PEEL OFF"

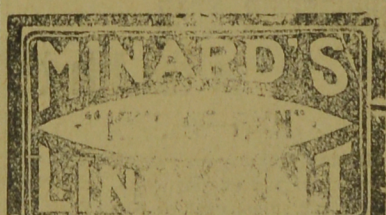
Can No Longer Take Salutes From Combatants.

England has decided not to tolerate the "swank" of honorary colonels from Canada within her precincts any longer. A recent cable from London says:

"The Canadian army council is issuing an order forbidding honorary colonels to wear a uniform in this country. This will be generally welcomed among the Canadian community here.
