RUSSIANS HAVE CAPTURED ERZINGAN FROM THE TURKS

Official Announcement of Great Victory Made by the War Office--Emperor Nicholas Sends Congratulatory Message to His Gallant Troops.

PETROGRAD, July 26 (via London).—The Turkish fortress of Erzangan, in Central Armenia, has been captured by the Russians. This was announced officially today by the Russian War Department.

The official statement announcing the capture of Enzingan says: "On Tuesday our gallant troops under command of Gen. Udenditchin, took in battle the town of Erzangan. As a result the clearing of Turks from Armenia has been accomplished."

The Emperor yesterday sent the following telegram to the commander in chief at Tiflis: "It is with joy that I have heard of the taking of Erzangan. From the bottom of my heart I congratulate you and the heroic Caucasian army upon your victory. I am delighted that the troops so quickly justified the confidence placed in them. (Signed) NICHOLAS."

IRISH SITUATION

IS IN BAD SHAPE

Status of the Emerald Isle Has Gone From Bad to Worse Since the Sinn Fein Uprising.

New York, July 25.—An Associated Press cable from London today says: "Apparently the status of Ireland has gone steadily from bad to worse, ever since the Sinn Fein uprising on Easter Sunday, for at present the country is in the hands of a temporary and makeshift government composed of a commission of judges, assisted by Major General Sir John Maxwell, commander of the British forces in Ireland, who still is maintaining military control over most of the ordinary police functions.

There is no viceroy in the place of Baron Wimborne, former Lord Lieutenant of Ireland, and since Premier Asquith's announcement that the Dublin rebellion had been an utter failure, none is likely to be appointed.

The office of Augustine Birrell, ex-Chief Secretary for Ireland, remains unfilled.

Great Britain finds itself at one of the most critical stages of the war, again distracted by wranglings over the old problem and with no light ahead.

JOIN 9TH SEIGE BATTERY

Will Enlist at St. John Tomorrow-- Will Return Here on Leave.

Mr. John H. McCollum, chief of police, whose tenure of office will expire on Monday next, will leave for St. John tomorrow morning to enlist in the 9th Siege Battery, C. E. F.

He will take the rank of sergeant and will proceed to Halifax to qualify for his rank. He will return to Fredericton on leave tomorrow night and will remain here until his resignation goes into effect.

Mr. McCollum served three years in the Royal Canadian Regiment, one year being spent on active service in South Africa.

He has had three offers to join police forces in other parts of Canada, one from the police department of the C. P. R., one from Winnipeg and one from a mining town in Ontario, some miles from Sudbury. He has decided, however, to enlist in the heavy artillery. He also had an opportunity to enlist in the new Field Ambulance unit being raised at St. John. He passed the medical examination here some days ago, but will be finally examined at St. John tomorrow.




