Peace Rumors Cause A Crash in Wheat

Chicago, Dec. 15 .- Developments in conection with Germany's peace proposals swept wheat values more sensationally down grade today than did the first peace offer from Berlin three days ago. A wild rush of selling began this morning as soon as the market opened May wheat fell to 156 as compared with 16614 to 1665% at yesterday's finish. The market as a whole opened 31/4 to 91/8 lower, with May at 1571/2 to 163 and July at 136 to 139, and fluctuated wildly for more than an hour.


