First, the scheme of assitance will apply to all men who oined the forces since the 4th of August, 1914, or who may oin hereafter, and to single as well as married men.

Second, the items in respect of which assistance will be granted include rent (ground rent and rent of business premises), mortgage interest, payments of instalments in virtue of contracts, such as purchase of premises, business or furniture, axes, rates, insurance premiums and school fees. Relief will not be given for the purpose of enabling any person to discharge such liabilities as ordinary debts to tradesmen.


