

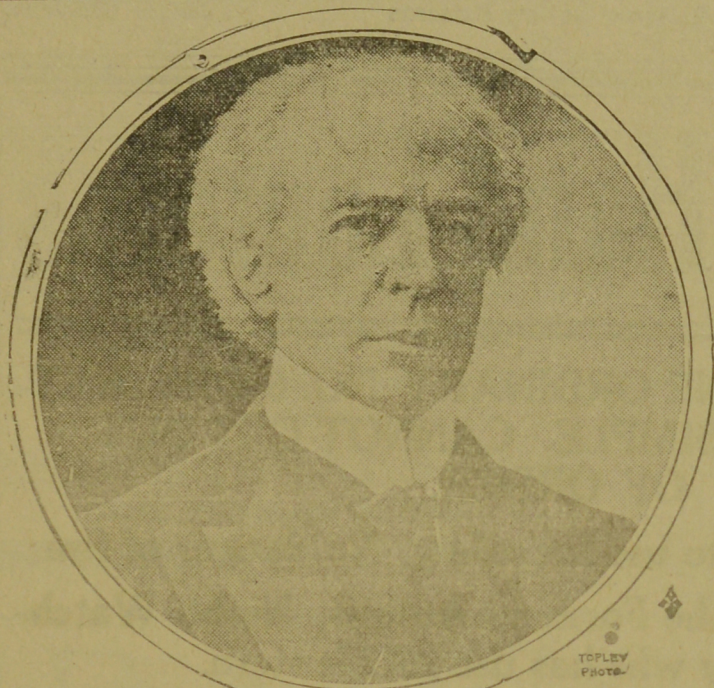
SIR WILFRID LAURIER IS CANADA'S GREATEST STATESMAN

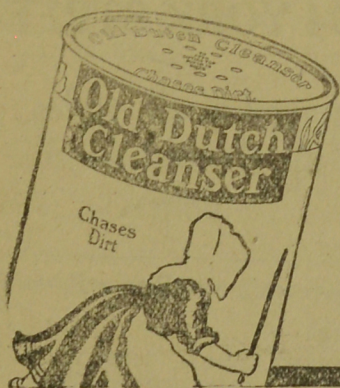

From the depths of a heavy depression he lifted Canada to a prosperity unprecedented in the history of colonization, establishing as he developed his native land free institutions and broad liberty of action for all men. He seized upon such men as Cartwright, Fielding, Mowat, Mulock, Fisher, Sifton, Paterson and Scott, gave short shrift to the incapable, and while he was master of his cabinet he encouraged vision and the peculiar genius of his cabinet lieutenants.

Never an autocrat, he prepared his case for presentation to the Canadian people on principle, and when he might have retired after going down in the most inspired moment of his career, he chose to fight on for the re-establishment of Liberalism.

GERMANS CAPTURE NORWEGIAN STEAMER

London, Oct. 26.—It is now reported that the Norwegian mail steamer from Bergen for Newcastle, Eng., which, according to advices received, was stopped by a German warship, has been taken to a German port, although it had no cargo aboard.

The Norwegian mail steamships form a connecting link between England and the Scandinavian countries and Russia. They carry many Americans and American mail, official and otherwise.

Although several of the steamers have been searched, this is the first instance in which the actual seizure of one of them has been reported.

BIG LEAGUES AND EXHIBITION GAMES

Chicago, Oct. 26.—Major League baseball players will not only be barred from engaging in exhibition baseball games, but are forbidden to increase their incomes after the regular season is over by indoor baseball, basketball or football.

This was the answer today of President B. B. Johnson of the American League to the protests of David L. Fultz, president of the Ball Players' Fraternity, against fines imposed on members for engaging in post season games. The action of the players' contract covering the points mentioned was exhibited by Pres. Johnson, who said that it had been approved by Mr. Fultz.

It forbids participation in "any exhibition game, indoor baseball, basketball or football, unless the written consent of the club has first been given."

"We decided not to permit the exhibition games, because the Hippodrome features could not be divorced from them," Johnson said.

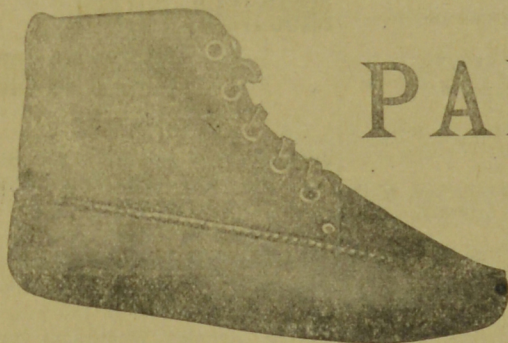
All employers of labor in said district willing to give preference to returned disabled soldiers as employees and all returned discharged soldiers wanting employment residing therein are requested to notify the secretary.

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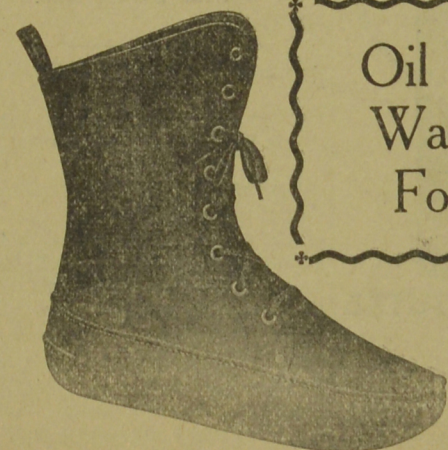
