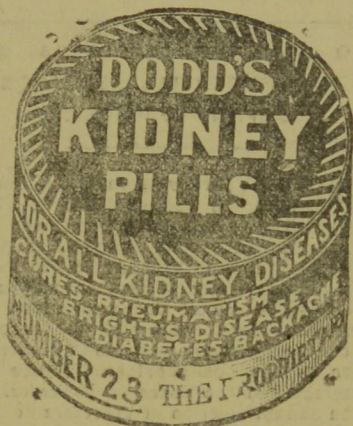
'THE BLACK FEATHER' PLAYED TO BIG AUDIENCE

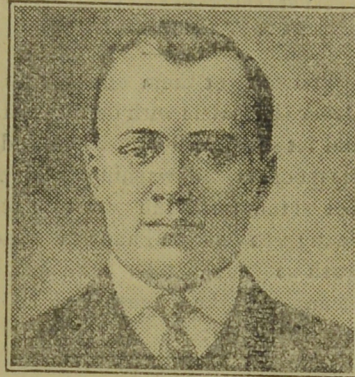

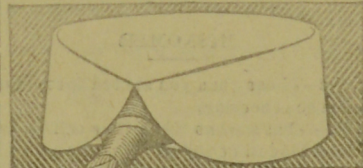

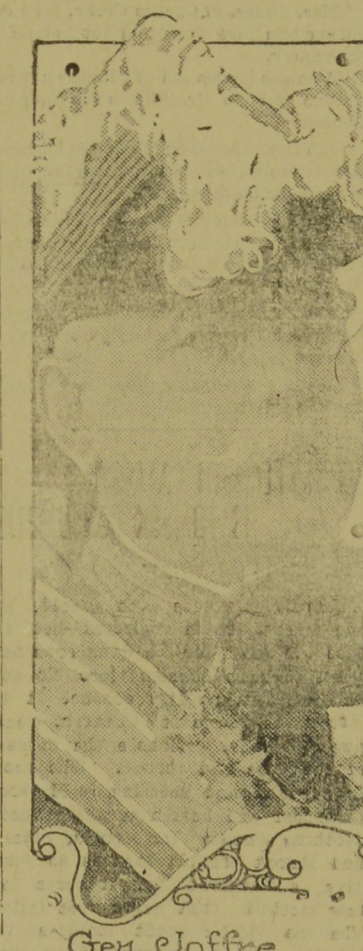
