

RECRUITING FOR

Of this number the divisional enistments were as follows:

London, 202; Toronto, 577; Kings ton and Ottawa, 694; Montreal, 446; Quebec, 41; Maritime Provinces, 193 Manitoba, Saskatchewan, 541; Alberta, 227; British Columbia, 603. The aggre gate enlistment is 358,105.


