WOMAN'S COLUMN

HOUSEHOLD HELPS.

Coal oil will help the house-keeper out of many difficulties. A spoonful of kerosene added to a kettle of very hot water will make windows, looking glasses and picture glasses bright and clean. Use a small clean cloth, wring it dry, and rub it over the glass, after wiping down the framework with an oiled cloth. Then proceed to the next window and treat it similarly on both sides. After that go back to the first one and wipe it dry with a large clean cloth, no more polishing is required and the windows or glass will look clean and shiny!

Kerosene will clean your hands better than anything else after blacking a range or stove. Pour a little in the water, wash your hands in it, then wash them in tepid water, and finally with plenty of soap and a stiff brush in hot water. Finish up by rubbing the

hands with lemon, rosewater and glycerine

When your kitchen sink is rusty rub it over with kerosene. Squeaky shoes are cured by dipping the soles in kerosene.

RECIPES WORTH TRYING.

Tomato Soup With Meat Balls.

Take 1 medium-sized can tomatoes, add the desired amount of water, let come to a boil; take 1/2 pound fresh ground hamburger steak with one small onion chopped in, season with salt, pepper and add one small raw egg, roll into balls the size of a walnut, and add to the boiling soup; season soup with salt and pepper to taste; let all boil together slowly 1 hour.

Catsup.

Take 1 peck of tomatoes and cook thoroughly. After they are cooked rub through a sieve. Add

to this 1-3 cup salt, 1/2 cup sugar, 2 teaspoons each of cinnamon, black pepper and cloves, 1/2 teaspoon red pepper and 1 quart of vinegar. Boil 4 hours and when cold put in bottles. This catsup will keep for 2 or 3 years, and is delicious on cold meats, beans, etc.

Molasses Drop Cakes.

Put 1-2 cup lard in pan, set on stove until lard is melted; add 1 cup sugar, 1 egg, (1-2 cup water) then all 3 1/2 cups flour, 4 teaspoons each cinnamon and ginger; sifted together with 1 teaspoon soda and 1 teaspoon salt. Drop about 6 tablespoonfuls into a well greased hot frying pan and bake in oven.

A NEW ROAD MACHINE.

Equipped with Powerful Motor—Will Soon be at Work Near St. John.

Something new in roadmaking will soon be seen on the Marsh road, in the operation of a huge traction engine which will haul 14 trailers in the gravel supply service.

The traction engine, a machine of the latest type, is equipped with an 80-horsepower motor. The trailers are being put in shape at Fleming's foundry under the direction of Engineer A. H. Taylor, who will have charge of the road work.

FOOD CHEAPER IN BERLIN.

Slight Reduction in Prices of Breadstuffs and Meats.

Berlin, Sept. 19 (by wireless).—The reduction last week in the price of breadstuffs was followed today by a lowering of the meat prices in Berlin. Roasting beef was reduced from three marks to two marks eighty pfennigs a pound. Other beef from two marks sixty pfennigs to two marks and forty pfennigs; veal from two marks ten pfennigs to one mark and ninety pfennigs.

CHILDREN STARVING WHILE AT SCHOOL

Condition of Belgian Kiddies Such That School Hours Have Been Shortened.

London, Sept. 20.—The want of food in Antwerp is so great that the children can no longer stand the strain of a full day in school, and class hours have been reduced on account of the pupils' debility.

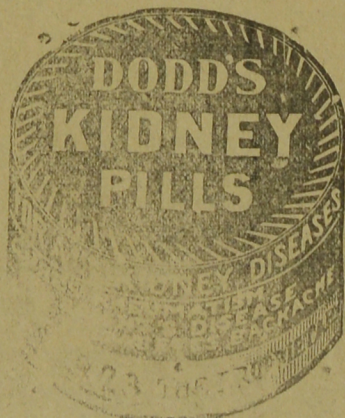
The significance of this can hardly be appreciated where people are receiving plenty to eat and prosperity is prevalent. If this is the state of the children, the condition of their parents can only be imagined.

The Empire has promised to support these people, to guard their interests and care for them and their children in their helpless state, but this report from Antwerp is one which should set Britons and Canadians to thinking. To Canada Belgium must look for most of her aid, for there are the life-saving fields of wheat that make the flour that is the one salvation of these people.

The Belgian Relief Committee has its branch at 59 St. Peter street, Montreal, and also sub-branches and local committees throughout the Dominion. These branches are exerting every effort to give these Belgian children—starving in their seats in school—the bare food that is justly theirs. The task is a big one and needs the co-operation of the father and mother of every Canadian school child. Two dollars and a half will save two of these children and their parents from starvation for a month. Why not do it now?

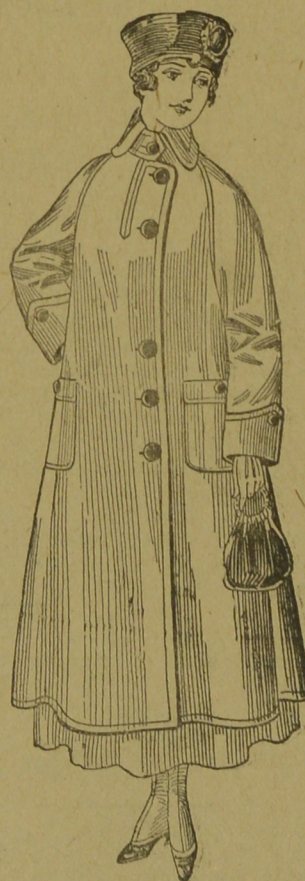

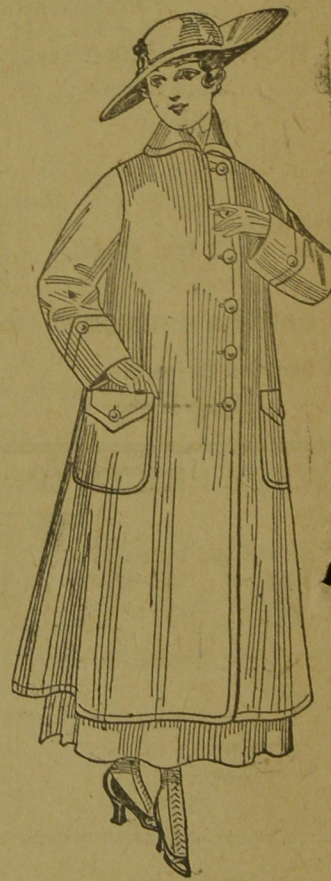
