Evidence tending to connect the reported movement to invade Canada at some point near Buffalo with the operations of German propagandists on the Pacific coast, which resulted in the indictment of German consular officials and their agents in San Francisco on Tuesday, was gathered by Doninion Secret Service agents in this ity yesterday.

According to that information, many of the German military officers who arrived in this country from neural ports, presumably to assist in spreading the German propaganda, are now warding the incendiary designs against es and tunnels, with which some of the German consular officials are accused by the Federal Grand Jury in San Francisco.


