

FREDERICTON'S LIST OF BIG TAXPAYERS FOR YEAR 1916

Those Who Will Contribute \$75 or More to the Cost of Running the Civic Machine---Mr. F. B. Edgcombe as Usual Holds First Place, Banks, Utility Companies and Mercantile Concerns Help Materially to Swell the Total.

Tax-bills for 1916-17 will be served on the ratepayers of Fredericton in the near future. Below is given a list of those assessed for seventy-five dollars or more. The list this year is larger than ever before. The Royal Bank of Canada pays the heaviest tax of the five banks doing business here. Of public utilities the Fredericton Gas Light Co. is the heaviest ratepayer, with \$2,200. The New Brunswick Telephone Company is second, with \$1,320. A number of estates pay heavy tax bills. The most prominent are: F. L. Morrison estate, \$1,454; James Hodge estate, \$1,441. Of mercantile companies F. B. Edgcombe Co. pay the largest tax, \$1,450.

Other companies which are taxed heavily are A. F. Randolph & Sons, \$1,400; J. S. Neill & Sons, Ltd., \$1,260; J. Clark & Son, \$1,008.

Mr. F. B. Edgcombe is taxed the largest amount of any individual, \$1,361. Other heavy individual taxpayers are Mr. J. Hugh Calder, \$1,062; Mr. H. G. Kitchen, \$948; Mr. A. B. Kitchen, \$839; Mr. J. F. VanBuskirk, \$789; Mr. Edward Moore, \$717.

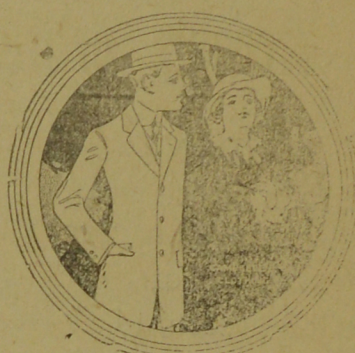

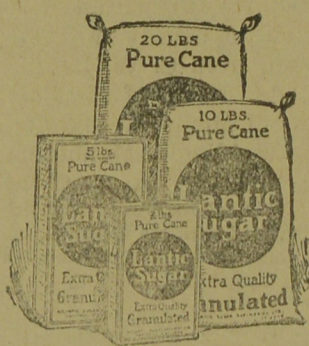
