HOUSEHOLD RECIPES

PEACH OR BERRY ROLY-POLY.

One cup flour.
One teaspoon baking powder.
One-half teaspoon salt.
One-half teaspoon shortening.
Two cups berries or one-quarter cup sliced peaches.
One cup sugar.
Two teaspoons butter.
One teaspoon milk.

Sift the flour, baking powder and salt into a bowl, rub in shortening very lightly, add enough water to hold the dough together; roll out to an eight of inch thick, cover with fruit and sugar, saving one tablespoon of sugar to sprinkle on top. Roll lightly like jelly roll and put into buttered pudding pan. Brush the top with milk, sprinkle with sugar and put the butter that is left in small pieces on the top.

Bake in moderate oven 20 minutes covered and 20 uncovered. When removing the cover you can add one cup of milk if desired.

This makes four large portions.

MEAT CAKES.

Two cups of chopped cooked meat; three tablespoonfuls cracker crumbs, two eggs, two tablespoonfuls butter, one small onion, salt and pepper to taste. Chop onion very fine, beat the eggs light with out separating, melt the butter, add to the cracker crumbs, mix with the eggs, meat and seasoning. Make into flat cakes and saute in drippings.

TO DARKEN GRAVY.

To color the gravy of pot roast, add a small portion of good coffee to it. It does not injure the flavor and does not require the browned flour.

HOUSEHOLD HELPS.

It is a good idea to keep a piece of sandpaper over the sink to clean pots and pans.

Never buy spices in large quantities as they lose their flavor before you can use them.

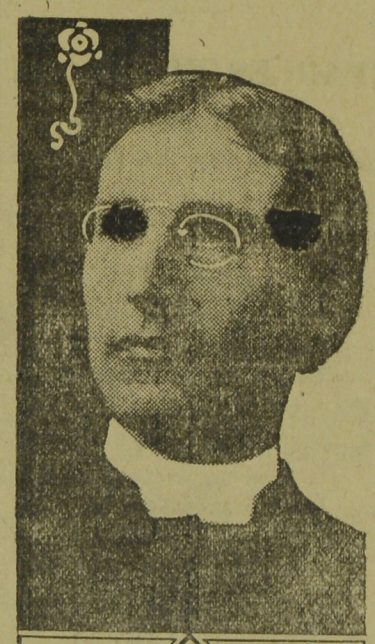

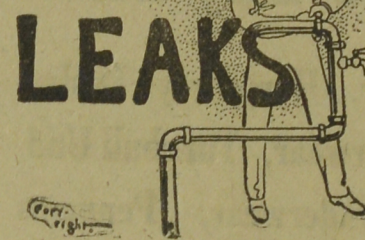
