WOMAN'S COLUMN

TO CUT STRIPED MATERIALS.

One of the most difficult things for the home dressmaker to accomplish is the proper cutting of striped materials. To be able to cut a striped dress well is a proof that you are by no means a novice at the art of dressmaking.

Skirts are always cut first. Lay the material flat on the cutting table, and if there is no "up-and-down" to the material, you will be able to fit the gores into each other cutting the material in an economical way. Remember to have the line of small perforations found in the center of each gore of the pattern run straight with the stripe. This will cause each cut edge to be slightly bias, and, when joined will look far better than if a bias edge was joined to the straight.

The center of the front gore must of course, be on a stripe. Double your material before cutting in order to have both sides exactly alike. When cutting sleeves be sure the material is doubled, and save yourself the trouble of having one sleeve different from the other, thus ruining the garment. Stripes should be run straight from the shoulder to the wrist in sleeves. Have the stripes run straight down the center of the front and straight down the

center of the back when cutting the bodice. Always allow plenty of material for seams when striped material is used, and be sure that the stripes match in the joining of seams.

FASHION JOTTINGS.

Fichus seem peculiarly appropriate with the Quaker gray frocks of the season. Any woman can look demure, no matter what her type, in a little frock of dove gray crepe de chine or pussy willow silk, with a fine batiste or net fichu crossed over her breast.

Some of these fichus are daintily hand embroidered; others have tiny frills of pleated net at the edge and usually there are cuffs to match the fichu.

SANDWICHES FOR LUNCHEON.

There is nothing that makes a more attractive luncheon than well made, dainty appearing sandwiches. They may not be elaborate, but they must be tempting and they must be fresh. Fresh bread and fresh dressing will go a long way toward winning you a reputation. Serve with iced tea or chilled lemonade. Here are a few varieties, all of them simple.

A famous modiste presents an afternoon frock of plain and striped taffeta whose bodice is almost hidden under a big crossed fichu of sheer embroidered batiste. The three-quarter sleeves have deep cuffs of the same material.

Bacon is often a desirable part of the luncheon sandwich. Without being heavy it still gives the sandwich the elements of substantiality. And bacon tempts even a listless appetite. To be cooked just right for a sandwich, the bacon should be made slightly crisp, not crisp enough, however, to fly to pieces when touched with a fork.

Water cress and bacon combine well. Spread a thin slice of bread with butter, pile one with water cress, lay two slices of boiled bacon on it, and top with another slice of buttered bread.

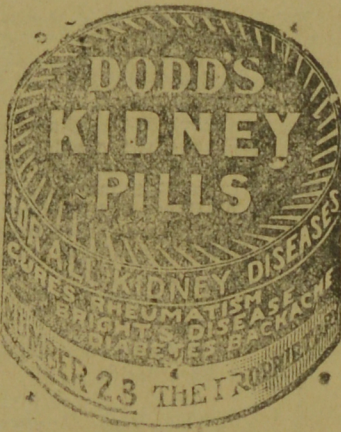

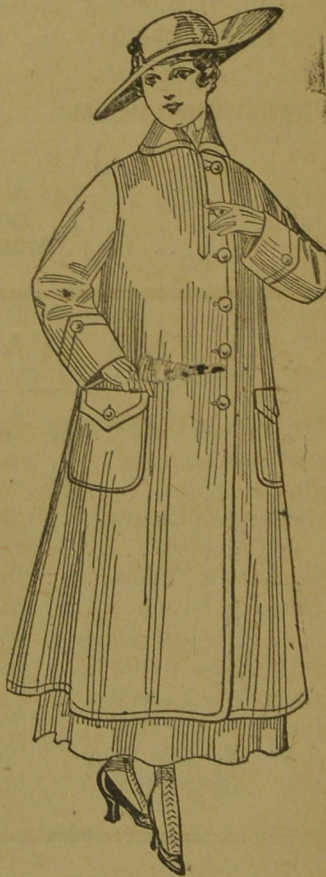
