### SEASONABLE RECIPES.

#### Honey Cakes.

Melt two ounces of shortening. Add One cupful of honey.  
 Grated rind of one lemon.  
 One tablespoonful lemon juice.  
 Two ounces almonds, cut fine.  
 One-fourth tablespoonful mace.  
 One-half teaspoonful soda.  
 Two and a half cupfuls flour.  
 Mix thoroughly, then cover and set aside until the next morning. Roll one-half inch thick, then cut in squares. Place in greased and floured pans and bake for ten minutes in a moderate oven. When baked wash over with a syrup made of  
 One-half cup of sugar.  
 Two tablespoonfuls cold water, boiled to a thread.  
 Let the syrup cool slightly before using.

#### Fruit and Nut Cakes.

Four tablespoonfuls shortening. Cream well, then add  
 Three-fourths cupful sugar.  
 Two well-beaten eggs.  
 One-half cupful milk.  
 One and one-half cupfuls flour, sifted with two teaspoonfuls baking powder.  
 One-half cupful raisins.  
 One-half cupful finely chopped nuts.  
 Bake in small pans and decorate with boiled frosting, small red candles and finely chopped pistachio nuts.

#### Almond Jumbles.

Two ounces shortening.  
 One-half pound sugar.  
 Cream, then add  
 Beaten yolks of two eggs.  
 One-half cupful of milk.  
 One and three-fourths cupfuls sifted flour.  
 Six ounces finely chopped almonds.  
 One-half teaspoonful baking soda, dissolved in one tablespoonful water.  
 Whites of two eggs, beaten to a stiff froth.

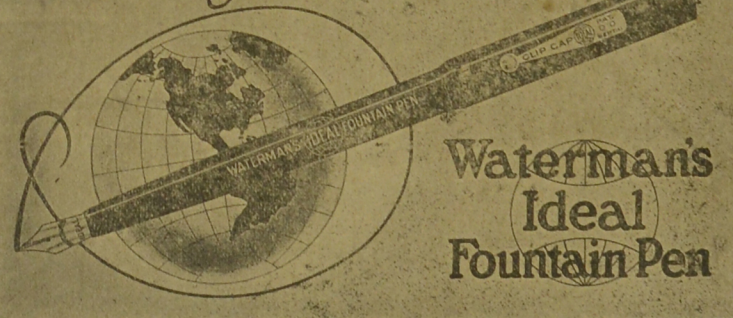
