SOME GOOD RECEIPES

Marguerite Pudding.

Take one egg, its weight in fresh butter, flour and bread crumbs, one tablespoonful of jam, one of marmalade half a teaspoonful carbonate of soda. Beat well the egg, add the dissolved butter and crumbs, flour, jam and marmalade, and the soda last of all, stirring briskly. Butter a basin, pour in the mixture, tie it down with the buttered paper and steam for an hour and a half, turn out and serve with sweet. half, turn out and serve with swee

NEW INTERNATIONAL Superiority of Educational Merit.

Eight ounces of cold cooked veal, three ounces of bacon fried, two tablespoonfuls of cream, three ounces of grated roll, one tablespoonful of chopgrated roll, one tablespoonful of chopped parsley, pepper and salt. Pass the meat and bacon twice through the mincing machine. Stir grated roll into cream, add egg, salt, pepper and parsley and, lastly, the meat, mixing all thoroughly. Form into balls the size of a nut, boil for five minutes in soup and serve hot.

Hickory Nut Cake.

Beat one small cupful butter and one and one-half cupfuls sugar to a cream. Flavor and add yolks of three eggs. Work through a sieve one teaspoonful baking powder and three cupfuls flour. Mix with other ingredients. Add slowly one cupful milk and one cupful walnuts, chopped fine, then the beaten whites of three eggs. Bake about three quarters of an hour in pans lined with greased paper.

The Great American Salad.
Every country has its favorite salad, or combination of uncooked green vegetables served with an oily or spiced sauce.

Most foreign salads carry a tang of

onions, leeks or garlic, flavors not much approved by the American Consequently, when Oscar, famous

chef of New York's famous hostelry the Waldorf, combined the two Ameri can staples, apples and celery, in a salad, the mixture was taken up by every cook in the land, and in a few yaers became the great American

The proportions used by Oscar for Waldorf salad are equal parts of celery and apple cut in small cubes or pieces, and served in the hollow of a leaf of lettuce with a mayonnaise Too much dressing should be avoided.

This makes a most wholesome and yet an inexpensive salad for either formal service or for the home dinner table. When a richer and more elaborate salad is desired, black walnuts, another typical American product, may be added.

Use canned fish or any cold cooked fish with 1 cupful of cold rice, 1 cupful of celery, 1 cupful of mayonnaise, 1 tablespoonful of onion juice, 2 tablespoonfuls of finely cut parsley, peppers or olives, 4 cupfuls of lettuce.

Mix the rice, celery, half the mayonnaise and the onion juice together. Serve on the lettuce with the fish in the centre with the rest of the mayonthe centre with the rest of the mayon paise. Garnish with tomato jelly cubes, parsley, peppers or olives.


