SEASONABLE RECIPES.

Moiny Croquettes.

A delicious hominy croquette is made from a cup of cold boiled hominy stirred lightly with melted butter and a little cream, teaspoon of sugar and a beaten egg. Roll in neat balls.

Cod Salad.

These fish make a very delicious salad, and can be combined with water cress, endive as lettuce. A boiled dressing goes best with them, and they should be flaked, mixed with a little sliced cold potato and sprinkled with finely chopped parsley and chives.

Baked Macaroni and Chipped Beef. Break enough macaroni in one-inch pieces to measure three-fourths of a cupful. Cook in boiling salted water. Drain and blanch in cold water. Cover

one-fourth pound of sliced dried beef with hot water, let stand 10 minutes and drain. Arrange alternate layers of macaroni and beef in buttered baking dish, having two of each. Pour over white sauce, cover with three-fourths cupful of buttered cracker crumbs and bake in a hot oven until brown. For the white sauce melt four tablespoons of butter, add three tablespoons of flour and stir until well blended; then pour on gradually, while stirring constantly, two cups of milk. Bring to the boiling point and add one-half teaspoon of salt and one-eighth teaspoon of pepper.

Corn Doodgers.

Scald 2 cups of cornmeal with 2 cups of boiling salt water. Mix thoroughly, spread thin on buttered pans, dot with bits of butter and bake.

Corn Soup.

It is something difficult to cook canned corn tender enough to strain. When this is so, put the corn through the meat grinder before adding the milk.

BOUGHT STEER
AT \$2.10 POUND

At the International Live Stock Exposition, the grand championship horn steer raised and fed by Purdue University, Lafayette, Ind. He weighed 1,610 pounds. The grand championship on carload lots was awarded to E. P. Hall of Mechanicsburg, Ill., Angus yearlings, which average to weigh 1,036 pounds. At auction of show cattle Armour & Co. bought the grand champion load at 42½ cents a pound. These cattle were bought for the Congress Hotel, Chicago. Armour & Co. also bought the grand champion steer, paying for the same \$2.10 a pound. The auctioning of this steer was most exciting and interesting. He was first bought by the Shorthorn Breeders' Association, after exciting bidding at \$2.05. Immediately their secretary announced that the steer would be resold at once to the highest bidder and the association would donate the proceeds of this sale to the American Red Cross. With the incentive in mind of making these proceeds as large as possible the bid was run up too \$2.10 per pound, at which price the steer was knocked down to Armour & Co. The prices paid for both the grand champion steer and the grand champion carload lot are record breakers. The amount paid for the grand champion was \$3,381 and for the grand champion lot \$6,927.50 or about \$461 per head.

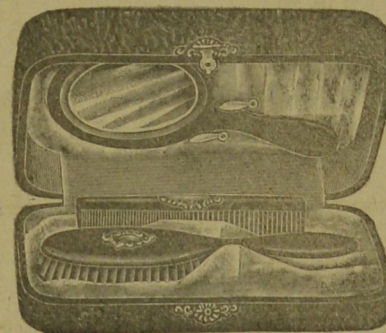
