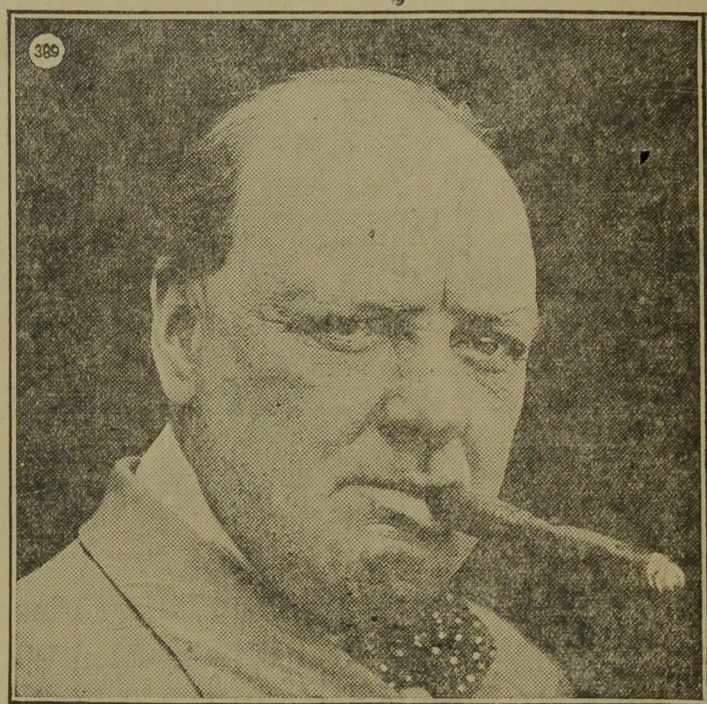

BROTHERS WILL BE HANGED ON DECEMBER 20

Montreal, Sept. 21—Lawrence and Norman Menard were sentenced to death today for the murder of John Earl Rurham during a hold-up at the offices of the Quebec Charcoal Supply Company, St. Ferdinand street, on the afternoon of February 26.

With the courtroom clock tolling the 12 strokes of noon, Mr. Justice Archambault of the Court of King's Bench pronounced the death sentence on the two brothers, after a jury had found them both guilty of the murder with which they were charged. They will hang at Montreal jail on Friday, December 20. The prisoners had nothing to say and beyond pale faces, showed no emotion at the sentence.

HUSBAND ATE CRACKERS IN BED DIVORCE PLEA

Chicago, Sept. 21—On their sixth wedding anniversary, Mrs. Julia Frejlak filed suit for divorce against John Frejlak, charging cruelty.
