THE NEW SWEATERS.

Angora knitted wool sweaters whether coat shape or middy blouse contour, are very ample in the skirt part. They often, too, are held into the figure, at the waist, by apron string straps of the same materials, which are wound about several times. Two colors are used in the same sweater, the border on hem, collar and cuffs contrasting with the sweater color—as a garnet sweater with a three-inch yellow border.

The silk sweaters follow the same lines, especially as to flaring skirt portions, and, if the middy blouse shapes, have string straps to tie about the neck under the collar.

DINING CAR SERVICE FOR COACH PASSENGERS

The Grand Trunk Railway system, which has earned a continent-wide reputation for the excellence of its dining car service, has just adopted a new method of drawing the special attention of the travelling public to the many reasonably priced dishes served in its dining cars. With the desire of emphasizing to all passengers, that the smallest order receives the same courteous attention as the largest one, the railway has designed a special menu.

This is to be distributed in the first class coaches on the train and it shows sample items served in the dining car. It is believed that this wider distribution of information regarding the facilities for obtaining a meal at a minimum cost consistent with the highest standard of service, will do a great deal toward removing this feeling.

IRISH M. P. BEATEN BY SINN FEINERS

London, Jan. 22.—About fifty members of the Sinn Fein, carrying the Sinn Fein flag, rushed upon the platform from which Thomas Ldon, Nationalist member of parliament for the East division of Limerick, was addressing a meeting in Limerick yesterday. Ldon was beaten over the head with clubs and kicked. He defended himself with a chair as best he could, but finally was beaten down and lay upon the platform bleeding.

Later he was taken to a hospital. The attack upon Mr. Ldon is attributed to a speech which he made in the House of Commons with reference to the disarmament of the Irish volunteers.

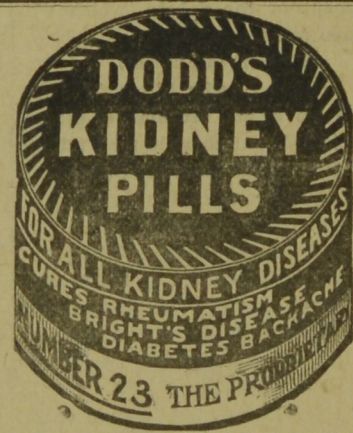

AN ENQUIRY ABOUT THE YARROWDALE

Washington, Jan. 22.—Inquiry has been made of Germany as to whether there were any Americans among the 103 neutral sailors brought in as prisoners of war on the steamer Yarrowdale. The inquiry was made entirely on press reports and not on any official information which has come to the State Department.
