

Dried Beef Sandwiches.

Put some chopped beef through the meat chopper and mix with an equal amount of minced celery hearts. Flavor with grated onion and moisten with olive oil and vinegar.

Cocoanut Sandwiches.

Mix half a cupful of English walnuts, three times that amount of grated cocoanut, moisten with cream and add two tablespoonfuls of sugar. Spread between fresh buttered bread.

Walnuts and Dates.

Mince pitted dates and walnut meats and mix equal amounts. Moisten with cream and spread between slices of whole bread and butter.

Nut Sandwiches.

Put nuts through a grinder and mix them with butter that has been rubbed with a spoon to a cream. Spread between thin slices of graham or whole wheat bread.

GRAHAM AND HONEY PUDDING.

To a half cupful of melted butter add two-thirds of a cup of honey, a half cup of milk and 1 egg well beaten. Mix and sift one and a half cups of graham flour, a half teaspoonful of soda. Add these and a cupful of seeded raisins. Pour into a greased pudding mold. Steam for two and a half hours. Serve with lemon sauce made from one cupful of sugar with three teaspoonful of grated lemon peel and the strained juice of a lemon. Cook these ingredients of the sauce for 15 minutes. Take from the fire and gradually pour on the beaten yolks of two Application For Retail eggs. Set in boiling water and stir until the eggs begin to be a little firm.
