## OF INTEREST TO WOMEN

## THE SANDWICH LUNCH.

Sandwiches are the standby of the child who carries a luncheon basket or box to school. They are also the luncheon standby of many housekeepers. Nothing is easier to prepare and nothing is easier to eat.

## Dried Beef Sandwiches.

Put some chopped beef through the meat chopper and mix with an equal amount of minced celery hearts. Flavor with grated onion and moisten with olive oil and vinegar.

## Cocoanut Sandwiches.

Mix half a cupful of English walnuts, three times that amount of grated cocoanut, moisten with cream and add two tablespoonfuls of sugar. Spread between fresh buttered bread.

## Walnuts and Dates.

Mince pitted dates and walnut meats and mix equal amounts. Moisten with cream and spread between slices of whole bread and butter.

## Nut Sandwiches.

Put nuts through a grinder and mix them with butter that has been rubbed with a spoon to a cream. Spread between thin slices of graham or whole wheat bread.

## GRAHAM AND HONEY PUDDING.

To a half cupful of melted butter add two-thirds of a cup of honey, a half cup of milk and 1 egg well beaten. Mix and sift one and a half cups of graham flour, a half teaspoonful of soda. Add these and a cupful of seeded raisins. Pour into a greased pudding mold. Steam for two and a half hours. Serve with lemon sauce made from one cupful of sugar with three tablespoonfuls of boiling water, half a teaspoonful of grated lemon peel and the strained juice of a lemon. Cook these ingredients of the sauce for 15 minutes. Take from the fire and gradually pour on the beaten yolks of two eggs. Set in boiling water and stir until the eggs begin to be a little firm.

## SPICED GRAPES.

For seven pounds of grapes use one pint of vinegar, four and a half pounds of sugar, one teaspoonful each of cinnamon, cloves and allspice. Skin the grapes, saving the skins for later. Boil the pulp and run through a sieve to

## USEFUL HOUSEHOLD INFORMATION.

A table of information which the housewife needs to be constantly reminded of is as follows:  
4 quarts make a gallon.  
8 quarts make a peck.  
4 tablespoonfuls of liquid make one teaspoonful.  
4 teaspoonfuls of liquid make one tablespoonful.  
4 tablespoonfuls of liquid make a quarter of a cup.  
3 teaspoonfuls of dry material make a tablespoonful.  
16 level teaspoonfuls of dry material make a cupful.  
8 heaping tablespoonfuls of dry material make a cupful.  
2 cups or 4 gills make a pint.  
4 cups of liquid make a pound.  
4 cups of flour make a pound or quart.  
2 cups of solid butter make a pound.  
Butter the size of an egg equals 2 ounces or a quarter cupful. One heaping tablespoonful the same.  
2 cups of granulated sugar make a lb.  
Two and a half cups of powdered sugar make a pound.  
Three cups of meal make a pound.  
1 pint of milk or water equals a pound.  
16 ounces make a pound.






