Important Meeting

Department of Agriculture and Repre-sentatives of County Councils to Meet in Fredericton, Tuesday, No-vember 20th.

The Fredericton Board of Health, District No. 1, having been ordered by the Provincial Board of Health, under the provisions of Section 39 of the Public Health Act 1911 to enforce compulsory vaccination for smallpox, all residents of the City of Frederic-ton, over the age of four (4) years, who have not been vaccinated within 5 years of November 1st, 1917, must be vaccinated on or before Friday, the 30th day of November 1st, 1917, must be vaccinated on or before Friday, the 30th day of November next, unless physically unfit, and submitting the Certificate of a duly qualified physi-cian to that effect. This Board has decided that instead of dividing the City into Districts and assigning a physician to a particular district, they will allow each physi-cian to vaccinate any resident of the city who may request him so to do.
