CANNING GRAPE JUICE.

When the grape juice season is at its height it is possible to secure the fruit so reasonably that it will pay the housewife to put up at least a few bottles of juice.

The first step is to crush the grapes by squeezing them (free of stems) in a clean washed sugar or flour sack. This can be twisted by two people, twisting in the reverse direction. Then take the crushed grapes and juice and put in a large enameled vessel to heat slowly. Those who like a fine product prefer to place the grapes in a pan of hot water to avoid discolorations.

The grapes should never cook above 200 degrees Fahrenheit. Otherwise they will be bitter and the product coarse tasting. The housewife can estimate this temperature by being sure not to let the grapes do more than simmer for a number of hours.

After the grapes are thus cooked to a pulp and a large part of the juice extracted, pour the juice and pulp into a flannel bag and allow to hang over night. There should of course be a vessel underneath the bag to catch the juice, for it is this that is to be canned. For a very clear product it is necessary to strain this juice a second time, to avoid all sediment.

Now fill this juice into good clean bottles or even fruit jars. Then proceed as in regular sterilization, using either a canner or even the home-made wash-boiler outfit. The time required will be thirty minutes in the average hot water outfit. At once take the bottles out, fit with corks which have been sterilized and seal the necks of bottles with paraffin.

It is a better plan to use small pint bottles, the contents of which can be used at one opening, instead of the large quart bottles or jars, which often spoil before the juice is all used.

The bottles should be kept in a cold dark place, never in a warm place.

if large, and into halves if small. Put the fruit while peeling in a pan of water to keep it from discoloring, until the entire amount of pears is prepared. Cook the pears until soft in clear water. Drain and use 1 quart of this water in which the pears were cooked, and 2 pounds of sugar, thinly pared rind of 2 lemons and 2 ounces of white ginger for 8 pounds of pears. Cook for ten minutes and add 8 prepared pears, cook until they are transparent. Seal in sterilized jars and store in a cool place. All ginger root used in pickling and preparing should be well washed and then sliced very thin.
