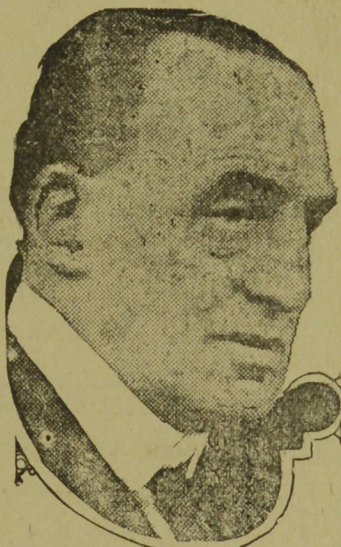

**PALESTINE JEWS**Stockholm, via London, May 21.—  
Telegrams from the Jewish societies  
in Palestine received by the secre-  
tary's department of the socialist con-  
ference here, say a fresh massacre of  
Palestine Jews, resembling the Ar-  
menian massacres, is threatened, and  
appeals are made to the socialists of  
all countries. The messages say the  
Turkish government has given orders  
for the evacuation of Palestine by the  
Jewish population and that the exe-  
cution of these measures is being car-  
ried out with increasing severity. The  
orders, it is said, are aimed at the  
Jews in Judea and Jerusalem, and  
later in Galilee.**ACQUITTED BY**  
**COURT MARTIAL**Havre, May 21.—Adolphe Max, bur-  
gomaster of Brussels, who was de-  
ported by the Germans in 1914 and  
confined in prison, has been tried by  
court martial at Kildesheim and ac-  
quitted, according to a report receiv-  
ed here. Burgomaster Max is said

men who have arrived from Tabaraca,

marine recently attacked a fleet of six  
boats, one of which was sunk. The

**CONSCRIPTION**Quebec, May 21.—Speaking on con-  
scription, Senator Choquette said last  
night that those who had recognized  
the principle that when England was  
at war Canada was also at war could  
hardly be justified in opposing con-  
scription. For himself, as he had  
opposed the former, he would oppose  
the latter also. He thought that the  
people should be considered on the  
question either by referendum or gen-  
eral election.**GROW RADISHES EARLY.**Easiest Thing Grown in a Small Gar-  
den—Won't Thrive in Summer.Radishes are the garden's first crop.  
Radish will not grow in midsummer;  
they thrive best in spring and autumn.On a quick rich soil some varieties  
can be matured in from 3 to 44 weeks.  
That gives you time for a few sow-  
ings, say about a week or ten days  
apart.Radish seed germinates in a larger  
proportion than most other seeds, so  
you need not sow thickly. But if you  
do, thin out the plants to give each
