#### SHORT MEASURE ON CORD WOOD

TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

To those whom it may concern:
Recently having occasion to help settle a dispute in regord to the proper measurement of a cord of firewood, I take the liberty of having published for the benefit of the general public, an extract from the New Brunswick Consolidated Statutes relating to the same, viz.: If those wishing to know the correct measurements of a cord of wood or bark will look on Page 2395 of said statutes they will see the following:

Revised Statutes—Title XVII. Chapter 93.

OF THE MEASUREMENT OF FIRE-WOOD AND BARK.

1. All firewood and bark, when bought or sold by measurement, shall be measured by the cord, which shall be eight feet in length, four feet in breadth, and four feet four inches in height. R. Sc. 93, s. l. part.

Despite this law being on our statute books there are a number of persons hauling wood to our city and are claiming that a cord of wood measures four feet wide, four feet high and tigt feet long, when the proper measurements are four feet wide, four feet four inches high and eight feet long, making a total of 138 2-3 feet. There are a number of our contrymen who have an idea that a cord of wood is 128 feet, but as I am herewith stating the total measurement of a cord of firewood according to the consolidated statutes is 138 2-3 feet.




