ROCHESTER GETS BIGGEST BALLPLAYER IN ORGANIZED BALL

Larne Kirby Now With Rochester Has The Distinction—St. Paul Lets Him go to International League

St. Paul, May 3.—Larne Kirby, the outfielder, sold to the Rochester club of the International League by Manager Mike Kelley, is a graduate of the Southern Association. Larue was obtained by the Saints this spring from the Little Rock Club. Kelley bought his release outright and met the player's salary demands.

Owing to a policy of retrenchment adopted by the Southern Association clubs, Little Rock was unable to pay Kirby the salary that the player considered his services were worth; and therefore the deal. Kirby's failure to take his work seriously is the main reason for Kelley disposing of him. With the Little Rock club last season Kirby hit well over the .300 mark. Baby Doll Jacobson, playing right field for the Browns this season, is leading the Southern Association in hitting.

Larue is a physical giant, standing about six feet two inches and weighing about 200 lbs. He is a mediocre fielder, being weak on ground balls. With the Giants he has failed to find his batting eye, but as he has hit in the charmed .300 circle every season since he broke into baseball his present batting slump is believed to be only temporary.

"STRANGLER" LEWIS WON AFTER LONG-DRAWN BOUT

Chicago, May 4.—Ed. "Strangler" Lewis was declared winner over John Olin early yesterday after they had wrestled two hours and thirty seven minutes without a fall, when the latter complained of a lame shoulder and conceded the match. Lewis was the aggressor throughout.

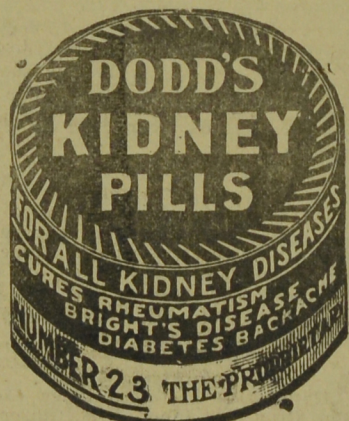
The work of both men was so clean that Frank Gotch, who refereed, had an easy time. Lewis weighed 228 lbs. and Olin 220.

WILTSE EQUALLED TEA-INNING NO-HIT NO-RUN RECORD

Toney's Performance of Wednesday Last No Better Than That in 1908 ---Wiltse Won His Game too.

Chicago, May 5.—While there was no record in baseball of two teams playing nine innings without a hit by either side until Toney and Vaughn had their remarkable pitching duel in Chicago on Wednesday last, Toney's record of winning his game and holding his opponents hitless and runless for ten innings has been equalled only once in major league baseball. George Wiltse, pitching for New York against Philadelphia on July 4, 1908, turned the trick and won 1 to 0. Several pitchers have records of pitching ten hitless innings, but they finally lost.

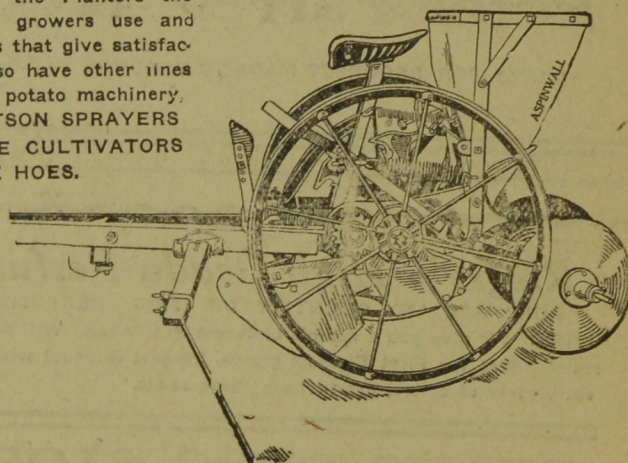
