GERMAN STEAMERS
MOVED FROM PIERS

Honolulu, March 6.—German merchant steamers taking refuge in this port were, under orders of the harbor commission, to leave their piers today and anchor outside the harbor.

It was said the order was issued to guard against possible damage to the vessels if they continued to lie idle at the piers. As the machinery on each of the steamers has been disabled, they will have to be towed to their anchorage. In the event of a southerly storm they will be in a dangerous position and in their disabled condition it is said they are likely to be lost.

WHY THEY ARE EXPENSIVE.

Milady's Skirts Cost \$10,000,000 an Inch, 'Tis Said.

Philadelphia, March 5.—Every inch added to Milady's skirt costs \$10,000,000. This solemn statement was made before the convention of shoemen by A. S. Anderson, of Boston, editor of the Boot and Shoe Recorder.

It isn't that this additional expense must be borne by madame or her husband, Mr. Anderson wasn't discussing dress fabrics. What he meant was that longer skirts mean shorter shoes. Orduna, From New York, Feb. 24, Arrives at Liverpool, Eng.

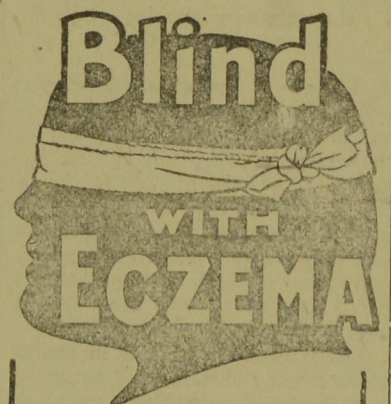

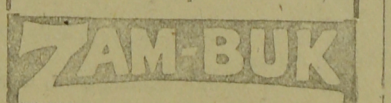

Sir,—The St. John Standard has published in its issue of the 1st inst. an article signed by T. J. Carter, Esq., of Andover, N. B., accusing me of having circulated in the French district of the county of Victoria the false statement that "If the government won the election conscription would follow in a few weeks and the boys in those districts would be forced to the front and butchered like cattle."

Mr. Carter puts the question: Is this charge true? I have held meetings with F. B. Carvell, M. P., and Messrs. Tweeddale and Burgess in the county of Victoria, and there was never a word mentioned by me nor by the other speakers about conscription. The statement made by Mr. Carter is too ridiculous to be published in any newspaper in Canada.

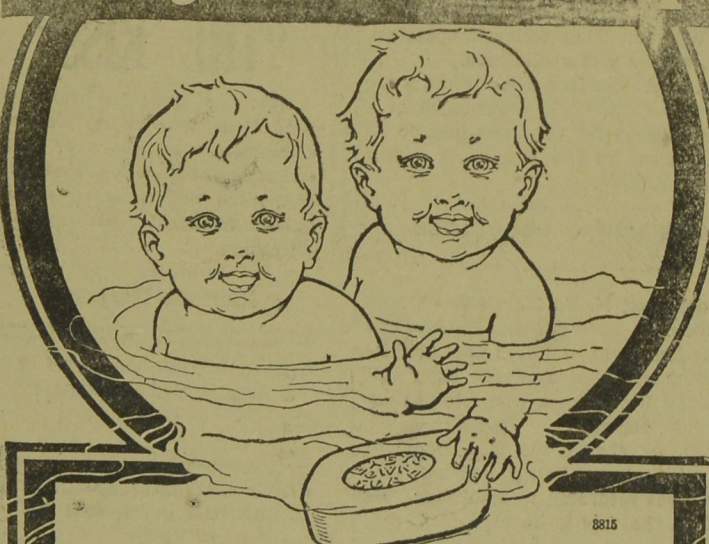
