THE USEFUL POTATO.

Potatoes—on everybody's tongue, if not in everybody's mouth. There are more than 100 ways of preparing potatoes for the table, and most of them are just as easy as the common ways. For example:

Potatoes in the Half-Shell.

Bake 6 medium-sized potatoes. Slice the top from each and scoop out the inside. Mash and add two tablespoonfuls of butter, salt, pepper, and three tablespoonfuls of hot milk; then add whites of two eggs beaten. Refill the skins and brown in the oven for five minutes. Grated cheese may be sprinkled over the tops.

Potato Fritters.

Two cups hot riced potatoes, two tablespoonfuls of cream, two tablespoonfuls of wine, 1 teaspoonful of salt, a few gratings of nutmeg, a few grains of cayenne pepper, three eggs (yolks of only two of them), half a cup of flour. Add cream and wine seasoning to potatoes and eggs well beaten, having the bowl containing the mixture in a pan of ice water. Beat until cold; add the flour. When well mixed drop by spoonfuls into deep fat; fry a delicate brown and drain on brown paper.

Potato Croquettes.

Two cups of hot mashed potatoes, 2 tablespoonfuls of butter, half a teaspoonful of salt, one-eighth teaspoonful of pepper, quarter teaspoonful of celery salt. A few grains of cayenne pepper, a few drops of onion juice, the yolk of one egg, 1 teaspoonful of chopped parsley. Mix and beat thoroughly, shape, dip in breadcrumbs, egg and crumb again. Fry one minute in deep fat. Drain and serve.

Potatoes Chateaufe.

Cut boiled potatoes into quarter-inch slices, sprinkle with salt, pepper and a few drops of lemon-juice. Put the slices together in pairs, dip in light batter and fry in deep fat. The batter: One cup of flour, half a teaspoonful of salt, a few grains of pepper, two-thirds cup of milk, two eggs.

A Supper Dish.

A hearty luncheon or supper dish is made with cold boiled potatoes, sliced, with layers of hard-boiled eggs and white sauce, the whole covered with buttered bread-crumbs and browned in the oven.

MANY SALOONS HAVE CLOSED

New York, Oct. 2.—Unable to cope with the multiplication of Federal and state taxes, and the increased cost of all intoxicants, one thousand saloons and retail liquor stores in Greater New York have closed their doors, according to estimates made today by excise officials. Yesterday, when the license fee of \$1,500, which must be paid in advance, became due, hundreds of places failed to open their doors.

HUN CITIES BOMBARDED

Paris, Oct. 2.—The German cities of Frankfurt-on-the-Main, Stuttgart, Treves and Coblenz were bombarded last night by French aviators in retaliation for German aerial attacks on French cities.

INCREASE IN RECRUITING.

St. John, Oct. 2.—The report for the week ending yesterday of men enlisting in the Canadian army in New Brunswick shows a decided increase over the week previous. Ninety-three men are recorded by the chief recruiting officer for the province, an increase of sixteen over last week.

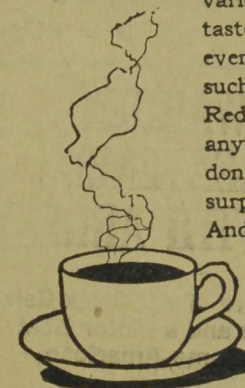
