New York, March 14.—The most cheerful veterans of the submarine zone are the buyers for fashion houses in New York, and when they arrive in force, as they did on the French liner Touraine, their wives and husbands, because buying is a co-educational pursuit, throng the pier and greet them with an ardor that shows their joy in having them back whole and untorpedoed.

There were 35 of them on the Touraine, and they brought the Parisian "models" for the newest vernal styles.

Seventy of them went over and some of those who have stayed in France are either waiting to get "something on" the first contingent or were reluctant to take the Touraine so soon after the proclamation of ruthless submarine activity by Germany.

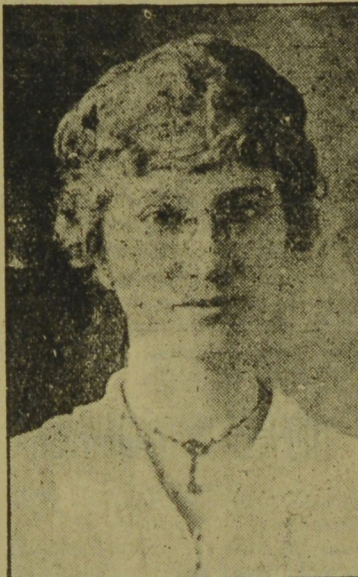

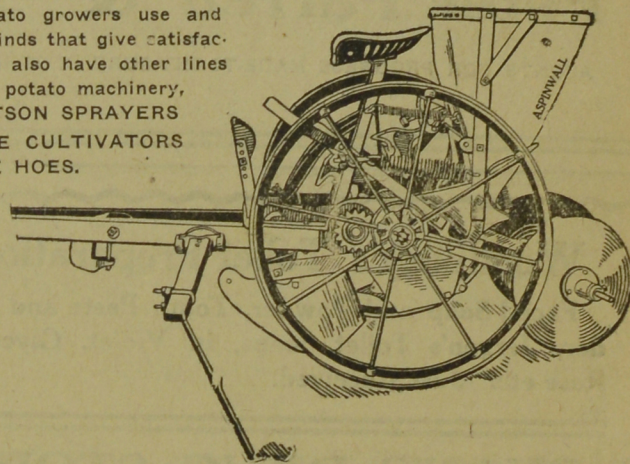
