GREAT MANY CHANGES IN ELECTORAL MAP

In New Brunswick there is an all round shakeup. Albert, that used to be with Kings, is joined to St. John city and county, the two electing two members.

Queens which formerly was with Sunbury, is now merged with Kings and known as Royal. Sunbury goes on to York. Victoria is added to Carleton and Restigouche to Madawaska.

In Prince Edward Island there is no change.

Going to the western provinces no constituencies disappear but new ones are numerous in Manitoba. Winnipeg has three seats instead of one, and the other new ridings are Nepawa, Nelson and Springfield.

In Saskatchewan the new divisions are Kindersley, Lost Mountain, Maple Creek, North Battleford, Swift Current and Weyburn.

In Alberta, Calgary and Edmonton each have two seats instead of one, and other new divisions are Battle River, Bow River and Lethbridge.

In British Columbia, Vancouver city gets two new members, while in the suburbs is the new constituency of Burrard.

Kootenay is divided into east and

west. Other new divisions are Skeena and Westminster District, as apart from New Westminster. The Yukon, where the election is always deferred stays with one member. Many constituencies which retain their old names are changed considerably by the addition or subtraction of new wards or townships.

In the offices of the clerk of the crown in chancery and the general returning officer, staffs have been working day and night for a month expediting election papers. The voting overseas may legally start as early as Monday next, but it is not expected to get under way till a few days later when the party leaders endorse their candidates and enable the military voters to know who is who.
