VARIOUS RECIPES.

Green Tomato Pickles.
Slice one peck green tomatoes and
6 large onions, sprinkle with 1 cupful
salt, and set aside over night. Drain
and boil 15 minutes in 1 quart of vine-
gar and 2 quarts of water. Drain and
mix with 2 pounds sugar and 2 quarts
of fresh vinegar, 1 teaspoonful cay-
enne pepper and 2 level tablespoonfuls
each of ginger, mustard, cinnamon,
cloves and allspice. Boil 15 minutes
and seal while hot. Remove spices if
a delicate flavor is desired.

Time for Blanching and Sterilizing.
Lest we forget, the following table
should be kept in the recipe book:

Cheese Patties.
Line patty cake tins with rich pie
crust rolled thin. Fill two-thirds full
with the following mixture: Cream 2
tablespoonfuls of butter, add 2 beaten
eggs, half a cupful of grated cheese,
half a cupful of bread crumbs, a tea-
spoonful of baking powder, salt to
taste and half a cupful of milk. Bake
for 15 minutes.

Potatoes au Gratin Grenovar.
Cut a sufficient amount of cold po-
tatoes into dice to measure two cup-
fuls. Prepare two cupfuls of cream
sauce. Parboil 6 onions and cut them
in slices. Grease a glass baking dish
well with butter and then sprinkle it
with fine bread crumbs and one table-
spoonful of grated cheese. Now a
layer of onions. Repeat this opera-
tion until the dish is full. Pour over
the cream sauce and sprinkle with fine

oven for 25 minutes. Cover the top of
the dish as it comes from the oven
with finely minced green peppers.

Oatmeal Muffins.

Mix 1 cup of our, quarter cup of
sugar, 4 level teaspoons of baking
powder and 1 teaspoon of salt, and add
3 cups of left-over oatmeal that has
been warmed and mix thoroughly. Add
one-third cup of milk, 1 egg and three
tablespoons of melted butter or butter
substitute. Bake in muffin tins for 20
minutes.

NEW CLASS OF WAR BONDS

London, Sept. 28.—The issue of the
new class of war bonds is announced
by the Bank of England. On and after
October 2, until further notice, the
bank is authorized by the treasury to
receive applications for five per cent.
bonds as follows:

"Bonds repayable in 1922, at 102;
bonds repayable in 1924 at 103; bonds
repayable in 1927 at 105, and an issue
of four per cent. bonds repayable in
1927 at par. These bonds are called
"National War Bonds" and will be is-
sued at par. The five per cents will be
subject to the income tax, the four per
cents will be free of the income tax.
