

AMSTERDAM, Aug. 6.—In the course of the patriotic celebration in the German Reichstag, Deputy Loringhoven, reviewing the three years of the war, is quoted by Vorwaertz as saying: "If, nevertheless, these unexampled German successes which in earlier times would long ago have brought peace, have not carried us any further, it is because the general world political and economical situation operates only in favor of our enemies, who have been able to enlist help from their ever-growing number of allies. This aid has enabled them to carry on the war until the present day, and so it has come about that our soldiers have been really cheated out of the fruits of their victories."
