"Soft Diet," a Sheet for Convalescent Soldiers, Will Appear Every Fort-night.

"Soft Diet," published by the boys of the Whitby Military Convalescent Hospital, was served to its patient-public for the first time in October.

Written and edited entirely by the men themselves, it proves that the only apology which they need advance is the one they hit upon in the leading editorial, the pity they had not done it months before.

In spired by shoe-shop arguments where "the weighty problems settled daily, if rolled out flat and placed end to end would stretch from Pay and Records Office, London, to No. 1 Queen's Park," it seems to be a chop-licking mixture of wit and wisdom, calculated to tickle a Tired Business Man and Frayed Veteran in the same spots.

It has no political affiliations. "It does not owe allegiance to any clique or party and it subscribes to no creed except the faith of the men who gave up their lives in Flanders, that freedom might not perish from off the face of the earth."

The fact is noted that in the month of September sixty-eight per cent. of the total available hospital strength attended the vocational training classes, and in the first week of October the percentage rose to 70.
