### MORE RECIPES.

**Pickled Green Tomatoes.**  
This is the government formula for pickling green tomatoes in brine: Wash the tomatoes, then in the bottom of a water-tight keg or jar, place a layer of dill and a handful of mixed spice. Pack the container full of sound tomatoes, add a top layer of dill and spice and pour over all enough weak brine to cover the tomatoes. Cover with cheesecloth and a clean board, placing upon the latter a heavy weight to hold the tomatoes beneath the surface of the brine. Let stand in a warm room until fermentation is completed and no bubbles rise to the surface when the receptacle is gently tapped. Skim off any scum which has formed, store the receptacle in a cool place and seal with hot paraffine to form an airtight surface. The brine should consist of half a pint of vinegar, three-quarters of a cupful of salt, 1 gallon of water. Stir until salt is thoroughly dissolved.

### Delmonico Potatoes.

Put in a baking dish about three cupfuls of potatoes cut in slices or cubes, season with half a teaspoonful of salt, a quarter teaspoonful of pepper, three tablespoonfuls grated cheese and bits of butter. Add 1 cupful of white sauce.

The white sauce is made as follows: Cook together 1 tablespoonful of butter, 1 tablespoonful flour, quarter teaspoonful salt, a pinch of pepper. When

smooth add 1 cup of milk. Cook until thick and pour over potatoes and bake for about three-quarters of an hour.

### Fig, Nut and Tomato Salad.

Scoop out the centres of ripe tomatoes, drain the pulp and mix it with chopped figs and pecans and mayonnaise. Fill the cavities with this mixture.

### Orange and Banana Salad.

Cut banana pulp into rounds with a potato cutter and mix with an equal quantity of cubes of orange pulp, carefully cut. Serve with French dressing on lettuce.

### Apples and Rice.

Quarter apples, sprinkle with sugar and cinnamon and bake. Cool and serve three or four pieces on a saucer of hot rice with cream.

### Baked Apples and Cocomut.

Sprinkle freshly-grated cocoanut on baked apples just before serving.

## DYNAMITER IS SENT UP FOR TRIAL

(Canadian Press direct wire.)

Montreal, Sept. 20. — Elie Lalumiere, one of the alleged dynamite gang was committed to stand trial before the assizes this morning on the charge of conspiring to commit criminal offense. All the other alleged conspirators were committed to voluntary statement on September 26th. The original charge against Elie Lalumiere was the attempted murder of Lord Athelstan and his family, but Judge Saint Cyr held that the evidence was not sufficient to commit Lalumiere on the more serious charge. Charles Desjardins, who was employed by the federal police to make a case against the dynamiters, was severely scored by the judge, as the evidence showed that Desjardins had taken part in most of the outrages and had furnished arms and money for the commission of these acts. The judge instructed the crown attorney to prepare a warrant for the arrest of Desjardins, who was not in court at the time. The seven other alleged dynamiters will appear on the 27th.

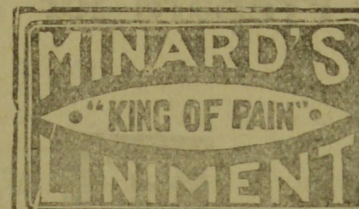

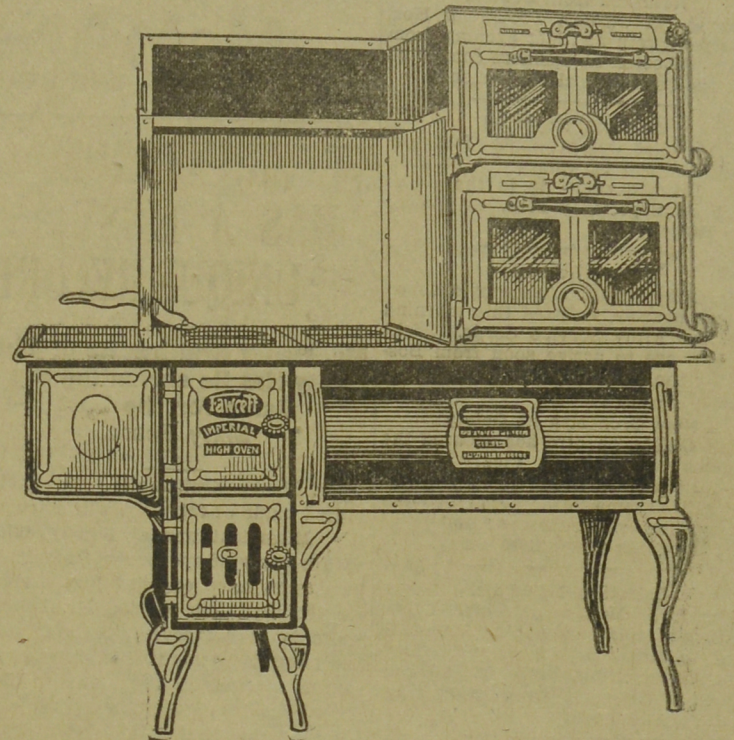
