INVALIDS REACH QUEBEC CITY

Quebec, Dec. 1.—A special I. C. R. train arrived here from Halifax today with the first lot of a big batch of invalids that will arrive from overseas at the local discharge depot. Another special train is due to arrive here this afternoon and a third this evening. In all some 1,500 invalids are expected.

WAS BUILT IN QUICK TIME

A Pacific Port, Dec. 1.—The first wooden vessel for the American merchant fleet to be launched anywhere in the United States will take the water here today. The ship of 4,000 tons dead weight, 290 feet over all, has been built in what is claimed the world's record time of 120 days.

UTILIZING KITCHEN WASTE

Washington, Dec. 1.—The kitchen waste at British army camps is being used to send shells against the Germans, according to consular reports today to the department of commerce. Glycerine sufficient to provide the propellant for 17,000,000 shells yearly is being produced from fats which hitherto were thrown away. The waste is producing products worth \$400,000 monthly.

BIG DEMAND FOR FRESH MEAT

Washington, Dec. 1.—Demands of the Allied armies for fresh meat have grown to such an extent that the British Board of Trade has requisitioned all the refrigerator space of shipping engaged in the frozen meat trade.

STEEL COMPANY HAD GOOD YEAR

Toronto, Dec. 1.—The directors of the Steel Company of Canada met here Thursday and declared the usual dividend. After the meeting it was stated that the company's orders were as large as they had ever been and that the outlook was excellent. The company has been particularly happy in its relation with its employees and there has been practically no friction. The subscriptions of the employees to the Victory Loan funds have been exceptionally large and the result probably will be made today.

FOOTBALL'S TOLL.

Chicago, Dec. 1.—Football exacted a toll of twelve victims during the 1917 season, including Thanksgiving games according to reports to the Associated Press today. The number was six less than in 1916.

DOCUMENTS MADE PUBLIC

London, Dec. 1.—Details of a series of documents published by the Bolshevik government relating to successive concessions offered to Greece for the purpose of intrigue to assist Serbia are sent by the Petrograd correspondent of the Times. These included an offer of southern Albania, excepting Avlona; an offer of territory in Asia Minor and other offers at the expense of Turkey. These all came to nothing for various reasons. One document, it is added, deals with a proposal to hand over Kavala to Bulgaria if Bulgaria joined the Entente Allies.

Another concerns Great Britain's offer of the island of Cyprus to Greece which lapsed owing to the refusal of Greece to help Serbia.

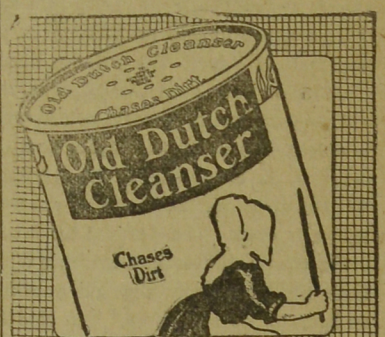

SECRET TREATY IS MADE PUBLIC

London, Dec. 1.—A secret treaty between Great Britain, France, Russia and Italy has been given out by the Bolshevik government, according to a Petrograd despatch of Wednesday to the Daily Mail. It comprises the terms on which Italy entered the war. Great Britain, France and Russia, according to the published text, agree to Italy annexing the Trentino, the southern Tyrol, Istria, Dalmatia, certain islands in the Grecian archipelago, and territory in Asia Minor and Africa. Article XV. of the treaty is reported to read as follows: "France, Great Britain and Russia take upon themselves to support Italy in her disallowing representatives of the Holy See to take any diplomatic steps for the conclusion of peace of regarding matters pertaining to the present war."
